### Confirmations

Confirmations will be emailed or posted as required. Please note that upon receipt of the confirmation you should verify that all information regarding yourself and your dog is correct and your dog is correctly entered in the events you requested. If information is not correct or your dog is not correctly entered you must contact the trial secretary before the trial date to have corrections made. *Changes will not be made at registration*.

# **Check In & Measuring**

Check In & measuring will be available from 7:00 AM to 7:30 AM. First dog on the line at 8:00 AM. If your dog does not have a completed AAC Measurement card you must have your dog measured.

# AAC ID Cards

If your dog does not have an AAC ID Card, please order it yourself before the trial. All dogs must have an AAC ID card and must present this card if requested by judge or trial secretary.

#### Agility Association of Canada - CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

**STARTERS STANDARD** - is open to dogs that have not earned the Agility Dog of Canada (ADC) title. Dogs achieving three qualifying scores under two different judges shall be awarded the ADC title by the AAC.

**STARTERS GAMES** - are open to all dogs that have not completed one qualifying score in that particular game.

**ADVANCED STANDARD** - is open to dogs not having earned the Advanced Agility Dog of Canada (AADC) title. Dogs achieving three qualifying scores under two different judges will be awarded the AADC title by the AAC.

**ADVANCED GAMES** - are open to all dogs that have completed one qualifying score in a Starters class of that particular game.


**MASTERS STANDARD** - is open to dogs not having earned the Masters Agility Dog of Canada (MADC) title. Dogs achieving three qualifying scores under two different judges will be awarded the MADC title by the AAC.

**MASTERS GAMES** - are open to all dogs that earned two qualifying scores under two different judges in an Advanced class of that particular game.

**SPECIALS Agility Class** - is open to all dogs, but is intended for dogs that are of a size or stature that limits their jumping ability. Dogs running in Specials shall jump one height lower than the height they would jump in a regular class. A-frame height is 5' and no spread jumps are used. Otherwise all other Rules and Regulations apply.

**VETERANS Agility Class** - is open to dogs 7 yrs of age (5 if in Specials class for 1 yr) or older. Dogs registered in the Veterans class may jump 1 or 2 jump heights lower than the height they would jump in a regular class. A-frame height is 5' and no spread jumps are used. Otherwise all other Rules and Regulations apply.

**STEEPLECHASE (all levels)** This game demonstrates the dog's ability to run and jump at high speeds while maintaining control on the a-frame and weave poles.



If you are coming from the North, it is the first Jinglepot exit – to the right off the Parkway.

If you are coming from the South, it is the second Jinglepot exit – to the left off the Parkway.

It is the driveway just before the 60 km/h sign.

# **Exhibitor Information**

### VOLUNTEERS

You will be able to sign up for the jobs you wish to volunteer for. You are asked to sign up for a minimum of 2 classes per day If, for any reason, you are unable to make your scheduled time, please have someone replace you. There will be prizes for helpers.

#### **MOVE UPS**

We will offer same day move ups, but you must advise the score table as soon as possible to assist us with the paperwork.

#### As there is no concession on site, lunch will be available for \$7.00 per person per day. Please include be sure to check this on the entry if you want lunch.

**<u>NOTE</u>**: A dog that has entered a trial & subsequently earns a title, shall be permitted to move up in class, as long as the Trial Secretary is notified outside of one week of the date of the trial.

If you do not contact the trial secretary, you will not be permitted to move up on the day of the trial.

#### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of the rules and regulations of the AAC, including but not limited to the following:

- This event is held under AAC Rules and Regulations and is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, pure bread or mixed breed, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.
- Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the rules and regulations of the AAC and shall conform to AAC specification.
- No leads, collars, food, toys or any other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time. The lead & collar may be used to enter & exit the ring, but must be removed prior to running the course.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show grounds and NO REFUND OF FEES SHALL BE GIVEN.
- All dogs must be penned, crated or on leash when not in the ring. All dogs must be under control when exiting the ring.
- Dogs who show aggression at any time on the show grounds and/or are uncontrolled by the exhibitor will be asked to leave immediately and NO REFUND OF FEES SHALL BE GIVEN.
- Exhibitors MUST keep crate and exercise areas clean. Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs. Anyone who does not clean up after themselves or their dogs may be required to leave the show grounds and NO REFUND WILL BE GIVEN.
- There will be no refunds, cancellations or changes after the closing date, except for bitches in season, competitor injuries and move ups as per AAC regulations.
- Upon receipt of entry, there will be NO REFUNDS, unless a vet certificate is provided. A trial credit MAY be issued at the host club's discretion.

I/We, the undersigned, agree that the host club has the right to refuse my entry for causes, which the organizing committee shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and the holding of the event and the opportunity to have the dog participate or be judged:

I/we agree to hold the organizing committee, the organization (if any) which it represents including its members, officers and directors, the Agility Association of Canada and its officers and directors, sponsors of the event, owners of premises upon which the event is held and their employees, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I/we personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim.
