In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and win ribbons, I (we) agree to hold this club, the Sarnia Kennel Club, its members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents, sponsors of the events, or trial secretary, judges, volunteers and the owner or lessee of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto. I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death, or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes. I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this scent trial, howsoever such injuries death or damage to property may be caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOUR AND LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. **It is expressly**

understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any ehibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Canadian Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Canadian Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Canadian Kennel Club or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses: During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off -leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

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Awards	Qualifying ribbons and New Title ribbons will be awarded to each team that qualifies.		
High in Class	Only teams who participate in the same difficulty level for all elements offered (Container, Interior, Exterior), and qualify in each are eligible to win High in Class. One High In Class winner is chosen for each difficulty level. The High in Class is determined by adding the team's faults across the elements. If there is a tie based on faults, then the team's times across the elements will be summed and the faster- finishing team will win.		
Mixed & Unrecognized Breeds	These trials are open to mixed and unrecognized breeds. In order to compete, mixed and unrecognized breed dogs must have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) from the Canadian Kennel Club and must have a CKC-approved microchip. Mixed-breed dogs must be spayed or neutered.		
	Unrecognized breed dogs do not need to be spayed or neutered. <i>A dog eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog.</i>

Moving Up	Section 6.9.1 A dog that is registered in the records of the CKC with an eligible number according to these rules and has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with these rules may be moved to the next level of competition if the schedule permits. The transfer must be on the appropriate move-up form and submitted to the trial secretary by the owner or handler at least 15 minutes before the start of the class.		
	Section 6.9.2 The Event Secretary shall amend the judge's book and the marked catalogue, which are to be sent to the CKC with the requests attached to the appropriate entry forms.		
	Section 6.9.3 If it is established by the CKC that a dog moved up to the next level has not completed the requirements for the lower level before moving up, then all qualifying ribbons and/or awards earned by the dog incorrectly entered shall be forfeited and cancelled by the CKC and the owner may be subject to disciplinary action.		
	Section 6.9.4 In order for a dog to be eligible to move up, the dog must be individually registered with the CKC, have a Performance Event Number (PEN), an Event Registration Number (ERN), a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) or a Canine Companion Number (CCN) before entries close.		
Bitches in Season	Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entries have closed, the event-giving club must refund the entry fee and the fee for the Temporary Competition Number providing the event secretary receives, on or before the date of the event, a veterinarian's certificate declaring that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial.		
Refunds	No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund.		

Temporary Competition Number (TCN)	A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) allows dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN. A TCN cannot be used for dogs that require a Miscellaneous Certificate			
	Number (MCN), a PEN or a CCN number.			
	Note: There is no CKC fee to obtain a TCN. However, a TCN 'listing' fee is required each time a dog with only a TCN is entered in an event.			
Event Registration Number (ERN)	All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events, and do not have a CKC registra- tion number, will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).			
	The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.			
Performance Event Number (PEN)	A Performance Event Number (PEN) allows a non-registrable dog of a CKC-RECOGNIZED BREED to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. To be eligible to receive a PEN, all of the following must be met:			
	 The dog must be of a breed recognized by the CKC (<i>not</i> on the CKC Miscellaneous Class List). The dog must not be eligible for CKC registration. The dog must be spayed or neutered. The dog must be properly identified with a CKC-approved microchip. 			
	A dog that is eligible for a PEN may not be entered as a 'listed' dog.			
Canine Companion Number (CCN)	A Canine Companion Number (CCN) allows UNRECOGNIZED BREEDS to compete in CKC performance events. To be eligible to receive a CCN, all the following must be met:			
Unrecognized Breeds	 The dog must be either an Unrecognized Breed. Unrecognized Breeds are not required to be spayed or neutered. The dog must be properly identified with a CKC microchip. 			
	A dog that is eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a 'listed' dog.			
	 All the above 'registration' numbers can be obtained: Online through CKC's Portal (Note: Individuals who have not yet used the online Portal will be required to create a Portal account before they can submit an application online); or By submitting a completed paper application by mail to CKC.
