**REMINDER TO ALL EXHIBITORS:** No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable event.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

Attention All Exhibitors:

All exhibitors are to physically show their dog's bites to the judge in the ring. Thank you for helping to prevent the spread of disease.

This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked."

Attention US Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted however they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques “Payable in Canadian Funds” or “At Par”. They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

The following **CKC CONFORMATION** classes (divided by sex) will be provided:



Junior Puppy	for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age
Senior Puppy	for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age
12-18 Months	for dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months of age
Canadian Bred	for dogs born in Canada; <u>champions in any country excluded</u>
Bred By Exhibitor	for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.
Open	for all dogs.
Specials Only	for any dog who is a Canadian Champion. A CKC Registration, ERN or MSC number must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing. The entry of a "listed" dog in Specials Only is not allowed.
Exhibition Only	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.
Exhibition Only (4-6 months)	puppies 4-6 months of age may be entered in <u>Exhibition Only 4-6 Months</u> provided the Owner has also entered an eligible dog in a Regular Class. <u>These puppies may participate in Sweepstakes, if offered.</u>
Baby Puppy	For dogs 4 months of age but under 6 months of age. These puppies do not compete for championship points. Entry into "Exhibition Only 4-6 Months" is NOT required. No listing fee is payable for Baby Puppy Class.
Veteran	For any dogs 7 years of age and older. <b>DOGS COMPETING IN THIS CLASS MAY BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED</b>
Brace	For 2 dogs not necessarily of the same sex and not necessarily by the same owner; judged as an identical pair – same color, size, gait, and same stride. Must be handled by one person on one lead. Must be entered in regular class or Exhibition Only.

### **CKC Non-Member Participation Fee - (24-12-3)**

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) *"these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"*

\*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, <http://www.ckc.ca> under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

**NOTE:** There will be a \$25.00 service charge for all NSF cheques and credit card declines. Tendering of an NSF cheque or declined credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the CKC.

#### **CKC Show Rules & Regulations**

4.1.5 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.

19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.





## CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Competing*	2	3 – 5	6 – 9	10 – 12	13 or more
Points	1	2	3	4	5
* includes the dog awarded Winners					

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall **NOT** be included in the calculation for points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF WINNERS, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 15.1.

In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS, which also places in the regular Group competition, shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

A dog awarded WINNERS which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All-Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 Championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In no case can a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour BEFORE the start of the show.

Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh:

## Things to Note....

1. The CKOC will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be held responsible for, or assume any liability, in the event of an accident or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
2. Showing correct information on entry forms is the responsibility of the entrant.
3. Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$15.00 including GST per copy.
4. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules
5. Entries will be acknowledged after entry by DogShow.ca and a judging schedule will be available after the closing date. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
6. ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
7. REFUND POLICY – COVID-19: If we are required to CANCEL the show due to any Alberta Government, City of Olds or Canadian Kennel Club guidelines, policies, or directives, a partial refund (based upon our unrecoverable costs) of entries will be reimbursed. In the event of any refunds, credit card and Dogshow.ca charges will not be refunded. If you are refused entry due to you not passing the COVID-19 Assessment Tool you will not be given a refund.
8. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH WHILE ON THE GROUNDS.
9. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs during the shows.
10. SHOW PRECINCTS shall be restricted to the entire Cow Palace, Regional Exhibitions Grounds
11. "ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES." If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and be on leash a maximum of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching area.
12. NO PINCH COLLARS ALLOWED ANYWHERE ON THE REGIONAL EXHIBITION GROUNDS. Exhibitors using Pinch/Prong collars will be excused from the shows/trials for the remainder of the weekend.
13. Group judging will follow breed judging through to BIS whenever possible. No two groups will be judged simultaneously. Should a conflict arise, the Chief Ring Steward shall determine which Group will be judged first.
14. The entire show site is designated "NO SMOKING" Exhibitors are not to be smoking near or about entrances/exits.
15. All exhibitors are to physically show their dog's bites to the judge in the ring. Thank you for helping to prevent the spread of disease.
16. Any show official, volunteer, employee or exhibitor shall not be subjected to any indignity by anyone at these shows. Should this occur the offender may be excused from the show/building by the Show Superintendent or his/her representative.
17. Unsportsmanlike conduct (e.g. loud, abusive, profanity ringside, etc.) will not be tolerated and could result in expulsion from the show. Please demonstrate sportsmanlike behavior while on the show grounds as a good example to other exhibitors and to spectators.

### **Benching**
