All dogs pulling 18 times their body weight will be titled as

Weight Pulling Dog II =WPT 2

All dogs pulling 23 times their body weight will be titled as

Weight Pulling Dog III =WPT 3

NWDA WP Champion-

Any dog pulling 23 times its body weight 3 times

NWDA WP Grand Champion-

Any dog pulling 23 times its body weight 5 times

NWDA WP Supreme Grand Champion-

Any dog pulling 23 times its body weight 7 times

Please be sure to attend the handler briefing at 9:30 am, as the judge will review the CARO rules and procedures.

Each dog must have a CARO ID number. You can get one in advance, or you may sign up for one on the day. Please bring the completed application form, and a cheque made out to CARO for the registration.

CARO is open to all dogs at least six (6) months of age, including purebred and mixed breeds, except bitches in season or dogs with injuries or illnesses which may cause the dog pain or great discomfort, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression that threaten the safety of other dogs or humans.

CARO welcomes handicapped dogs and handicapped handlers.

In order to earn a rally title, a dog must earn 3 legs, under at least two different judges. All dogs must start in Novice, regardless of other titles, and must be handled by the owner, or a member of their immediate family.

Dogs must wear a buckle or snap collar, or non-restrictive harness. Martingale, choke, or prong collars, and no-pull harnesses are not allowed.

Food is allowed in Novice and Advanced, as a reward only, at the end of a stationary exercise, and cannot be used to 'lure' a dog.
