NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club.

The non member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.

In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non member residents of Canada and is not applicable to Canadian Kennel Club members .



To comply with CKC Regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show Secretary after the closing date and time.

All Entry Fees should be forwarded to our Show Secretary prior to Closing Date & Time. Personal cheques & money orders for the full value only will be accepted and must be made payable to <u>THE CHOW CLUB OF CANADA</u>

No post dated cheques will be accepted. A post dated cheque is one that is dated after the receipt of the entry. All N.S.F. cheques will be subject to a charge of \$20.00. N.S.F. cheques are considered

non-payment of entry fee and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show.

Attention USA Exhibitors: Please note that due to constantly fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US Funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not make cheques "Payable In Canadian Funds" or "At Par", they will NOT be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge you to purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You!

Veteran Class will be divided as follows:

7 years up to 9 years, 9 years up to 12 years, 12 years and older

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (at the judge's discretion) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

Non-Regular Classes

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes <u>must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes</u>, Specials <u>Only or Exhibition Only</u>.

Stud Dog Class: shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only.
Brood Bitch Class: shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her progeny only.
Brace Class: a brace shall be judged as a "similar" pair, size, gait & same stride. The term "identical" has been replaced by "similar" due to removal of the "same colour" requirement.
Head Class: Judging is only on head
Gait Class: Judging is only on gait.

POINTS

Chapter 20, Section 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship Show held under the CKC Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of Championship Points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of Championship Points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder.

Section 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

To determine the number of Championship Points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breeds awards Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth. **NOTE: In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the Judge shall <u>NOT</u> be included in the calculation of Championship Points.**

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

- 1. Send a photocopy of the dog's Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN.
- 2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
- 3. Ensure that you provide the CKC with your full return address to enable the ERN to be sent to you
- 4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA/MasterCard number and expiry date, the card holders name and signature.

This Event Registration Number **MUST** be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "LISTED", however, failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

CONFORMATION MOVING UP TO SPECIALS ONLY

A dog individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirement for a Championship in accordance with CKC Rules, after the closing date and time for the show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "specials Only", providing the request is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING and on the appropriate form at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. When one or more Championship shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving a Class dog to Specials must be made a minimum one hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up.

Puppy Sweeps

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes or in Specials Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

Baby Puppy Class:	for Chow Chows at least 3 months of age up to but not including 6 months.
Junior Class:	for Chow Chows at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months
Senior Class:	for Chow Chows at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months
12-18 Open:	for Chow Chows at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best In Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth place in each class as well as to Best In Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps.

Veteran Sweeps

Veteran Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

7 years up to 9 years: 9 years up to 12 years: 12 years of age & older: for Chow Chows at least 7 yrs of age up to but not including 9 yrs for Chow Chows at least 9 yrs of age up to but not including 12 yrs for Chow Chows 12 years of age and older.

Sweepstakes Prize Distribution

For both Puppy and Veteran Sweepstakes the Class Winners will compete for Best In Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows: 50% of the Entry Fee for each sweeps class will go to the winner of each class 15% of the Total Sweeps Entry Fees will go to the Best In Sweeps

10% of the Total Sweeps Entry Fee will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps

25% will be retained for administrative purposes.

DOG SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

A copy of the CKC rules pertaining to Conformation Shows is available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Each exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the rules of the CKC regarding their event. The Dog Show Rules Section 4.1.3 states "a Judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out'.

The Dog Show Rules Section 4.1.6 states "no person may approach a judge, either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing to favour his entry. Disciplinary action may be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act".

GENERAL INFORMATON

- 1. The Show Superintendent will be in complete charge of these events, which are governed by CKC rules.
- 2. The Building will be open Thursday 17th August at 1:00 p.m. for set up, The building will open daily at 7:00 a.m.
- 3. To comply with TOWN regulations NO SMOKING WILL BE PERMITTED WITHIN THE CONFINES OF THE BUILDING.
- 4. Dogs should be on standby at their respective areas 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging. Judges are not required to wait for late arrivals and will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. There will be no PA system used to call dogs to the ring. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to advise that a dog is absent.
- 5. All exhibitors will be held responsible for CLEAN-UP on the show grounds and surrounding areas, for their own dogs or dogs they are handling.
- Additionally, CLEAN-UP after your dog(s) at your motel or campground. PLEASE FOLLOW THIS RULE SO THAT OUR ARENA AND MOTEL PRIVILEDGES ARE NOT REVOKED.
- 7. The Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. The New Brunswick Kennel Club will not be responsible for equipment left in the building or on site overnight.

<u>Please ensure that you keep your area CLEAN</u> Clean Up Outside after your dog is exercised.
