A class dog awarded BEST IN SHOW at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In **no** case may a dog earn more than **five (5)** points at a **single show**.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges and (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number and (c) have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level (15.1.13)

**Best Puppy in Breed**—Where a dog awarded Best of Breed is not a puppy, those puppies which have not been defeated either directly or indirectly by another puppy in the breed will compete for this award. Judging follows the award for Best of Breed. A puppy awarded Best Puppy in Breed is **NOT** required to stay to compete for Best Puppy in Group (15.3.1f)

### **MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS**

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or has an ERN number at the time of closing of the entries, and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 20 of the Dog Show Rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, but whose championship is yet unconfirmed by the CKC may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing that the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing at least one (1) hour prior to the BREED JUDGING at the show by the owner or handler.

**Effective January, 1994:** If your dog has the required number of Championship points and you do not have your registration number before entries close, and you receive your registration **BEFORE** the date of the show, you may move your dog up to SPECIALS if you provide the Show Secretary with the registration number and dog has been entered in the classes as a **LISTED** dog. Listing fees, however, **WILL NOT be refunded.**

**AN ERROR IN AN AGE SPECIFIED CLASS, DATE OF BIRTH, OR SEX, MAY BE AMENDED ON THE ENTRY FORM UP TO ONE HOUR BEFORE THE START OF THE BREED IN QUESTION 8.2.5**

### **DOG SHOW RULE 4.7.1**

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. Infringements of this rule are subject to disciplinary action.

**DOG SHOW RULE 11.1 (UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT)** it shall be deemed unsportsmanlike conduct if a person during the running of, or in connection with an event, abuses or harasses a **Judge,**

**Show Official, or any other person present in any capacity** at the event.

## **OBEDIENCE & RALLY TRIALS—GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

### **CKC Obedience and Rally Rule Changes for COVID**

Clubs will follow all Federal, Provincial and local health rules when holding a trial and the protocol will be detailed in the Premium list. Judges, Officials, and handlers will abide by the rules specified.

The following are allowable temporary changes to the obedience Rules and Regulations that a club may opt to use during their event while operating under COVID restrictions. However, any other changes to any other rule not mentioned here will not be allowed.

\*Judges may wear a mask even if not required by the club.

\*The Chair or table where the leash and other equipment is to be placed should be located at a convenient place determined by the judge but can be located in the ring or if not appropriate, just outside of the ring such that the handler can obtain the item without leaving the ring.

\*If a chair or table or any other surface is used to hold leashes, dumbbells, gloves or any other equipment owned by the handler, that surface must be sanitized immediately after use. Paper can be placed on the surface if sanitizing is not done, but that paper must be removed immediately after use, disposed of appropriately and replaced ready for the next exhibitor.

\*If a re-throw of the dumbbell is required, the handler should be allowed to ask the dog to stay and the handler will go and pick up the dumbbell and return to where the dog was left. If the dog moves during this process, it will not be judged unless it is out of control.

\*For the article exercise in Utility, the handler can retrieve the articles to be scented from the article bag and put them on the 'article' chair.

\*Score sheets should not be given out to competitors in the ring, but the club may pass the scoresheet information on to the competitors electronically or some other 'touch free' means.

\*In the Rally Advanced Class, the handler can put the leash in their pocket or hang it around the neck as in the Pre-Novice recall.

\*The exhibitor may either leave the dog on a sit stay or heel with the dog to the location of the chair to both obtain and return their leash and articles used during the exercises.

\*It is recommended that the club publish either in the premium list or judging schedule or both, the modified rules that it is adopting for their event.

### **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP—CONFORMATION charge: \$2.00 per entry**

Pee Wee—ages 4-6 inclusive, non-competitive

Jr. Novice: 7-10 inc. who have NOT won 6 first places in the same classes with competition

Jr. Open: 7-10 inc. who HAVE won 6 first places in the same class with competition

Intermediate Novice: 11-14 inc. who have NOT won 6 first places in the same class with competition

Intermediate Open: 11-14 inc. who HAVE won 6 first places in the same class with competition

Sr. Novice: 15 up to 18 who have NOT won 6 first places with competition

Sr. Open: 15 up to 18 who HAVE won 6 first places with competition or for any handler who has progressed through Jr. Open and feels he/she can compete at this level. Also for those who have received monetary sums for handling.

### **JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP OBEDIENCE charge: \$2.00 per entry**

Jr. Novice A---7-11 inc. who have NOT earned 300 points in a Jr. Obedience Class

Sr. Novice A---12-18 inc. who have NOT earned 300 points in a Jr. Ob. Class

Jr. Novice B---7-11 inc. who have NOT earned 300 points

Sr. Novice B---12-18 inc. who have NOT earned 300 points

Jr. Novice – 7-11 inc. who have not earned 300 points in the Open Class. Dog must have it's C.D. title

Sr. Open A—12-18 inc. who have not earned 300 points in the Open Class. Dog must have it's C.D. title.

## **OBEDIENCE CLASSIFICATIONS**

**PRE NOVICE** is an elective class and shall be for any dog or any rec. or listed, mixed or unrecognized breed which has not earned the title of P.C.D.

**NOVICE A** shall be for any dog of any rec., listed, mixed or unrecognized breed which hasn't earned the title of C.D. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. No person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a C.D.X. title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.

**NOVICE B** shall be for any dog of any rec. listed, mixed or unrecognized breed which has not earned the title of C.D.

**NOVICE C** shall be for any dog of any rec. listed, mixed or unrecognized breed that has earned the C.D. title or any higher Obedience titles.

**NOVICE INTERMEDIATE** is an elective class and shall be for any dog of any rec., listed, mixed or unrecognized breed that has earned a C.D. or any higher obedience trial titles.

**OPEN HA or 18A** The open A class shall be for any dog of any rec., listed, mixed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in these classes

**UTILITY A** shall be for any dog of any rec., listed, mixed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D.X., but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.CH. may NOT handle in this class

**UTILITY B** shall be for any rec., listed, mixed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D.X. or U.D.

## **RALLY CLASSIFICATIONS**

**NOVICE A** dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally novice (R.N.) title or any CKC Obedience Title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate families. No handler who has exhibited dogs through a CDX title or instructed on a regular basis will be eligible for the Novice A Class. No dog may be entered in Rally Novice A & B in any one trial. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

**NOVICE B** any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle a dog in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class

**RALLY INTERMEDIATE** The Rally Intermediate class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Rally Advanced Classes

**ADVANCED A** This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title but have not won the Rally R.A. title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate families. No Dog may be entered in the Rally Advanced A & B in any one trial. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

**ADVANCED B** this class will be for dogs that have won the Rally RN title. A dog may continue to compete in this class indefinitely.

The owner or any other person may handle a dog in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

**EXCELLENT A** this class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (RA.) title but have not won the Rally R.E. title or any CKC Novice Obedience Title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or member of their immediate families. No dog may be entered in Rally Excellent A & B in any one trial. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

**EXCELLENT B** This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally RA title. A dog may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle a dog in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class

**RALLY MASTER** This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.E. title. A dog completing the R.M. Title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

**SIZE OF RALLY RING: 40' BY 60'**

**The Dog show is NOT OPEN to the General Public**

Please make sure you are aware of all of the COVID and General Rules

**WAIVERS must be completed and signed daily.**

**MASKS** must be worn **IN THE RING** and must be **WORN PROPERLY** (mouth and nose completely covered)

**SOCIAL DISTANCING (2 meters – 6 feet)** is mandatory

**Show Site Access Process:** Waiver is to be handed to a club volunteer upon arrival at the show site, attendance wrist band will be provided at this time only.

**NO PUBLIC CATALOGUE** will be available. **Know your numbers when picking up armbands.**

The entry of a dog cannot be altered or cancelled after entries close except in the case of error in specified class, date of birth or sex  
Smoking is not allowed in the building

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, sick, lame or in season (except in the case of Obedience or Rally entries) or excused by the judge or veterinarian or barred from competition because it was incorrectly entered.

Obedience Exhibitors: any dog holding the American title in a particular class must enter the "B" class in Canada in that Obedience Class. Fees for a bitch in season will be refunded providing the owner/Agent produces a veterinarian's certificate TWO hours prior to judging.

The Fort Garry Kennel Club will use diligence and care for the safety of all dogs exhibited but it cannot be responsible for the loss or damage of livestock, persons or property whether the result of accident or otherwise.

Dogs not entered in the shows will not be allowed on the premises except dogs entered for EXHIBITION ONLY

If, because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the Fort Garry Kennel Club it is impossible to open or complete the show(s) NO refund of entry fee(s) will be made.
