General Information

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Eligibility

Scent participation is open to all purebred and mixed breed dogs at least 6 months of age that are individually registered with the CKC, or have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or a Performance Event Number (PEN) or eligible for the registration with the CKC or have a

Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed, or have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it's a mixed breed.

Bitches in season

Females in season may not enter and are not allowed on the event grounds. When a bitch comes into season after the entry has closed, a veterinarian's note certifying the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the event must reach the secretary on or before the start of the event. A full refund of entry fees and listing fees will be given.

EVENT

Verification that your entries have been received will be emailed to you no later than six days before the event date. PLEASE contact us prior to the event date if you have not received an emailed confirmation from us.

Scent Detection Levels Offered

Instinct, Novice, Open, Excellent and Masters (Containers, Interior and Exterior). Limited class entries.

Exhibitors CANNOT compete in the same component at the same level with multiple dogs.

NO move ups will be permitted.

NOTE Instinct is an entry on its own or can be combined with Novice only. It cannot be combined with Open, Excellent or Masters levels.

RIBBONS and TROPHIES

Flat, qualifying ribbons will be awarded for all qualifying teams New title rosettes will be offered

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

The CKC requires all owners of unregistered, recognized breeds entering events to obtain a Temporary Competition Number (TCN). TCNs will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).
