In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Show and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Hub City Kennel & Obedience Club, their members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes. I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.

ADDITIONAL SHOW INFORMATION

OFFICIAL CKC ENTRY FORMS

<u>ENTRIES MUST BE TYPED OR DISTINCTLY PRINTED</u>. Owners are responsible for errors on entries. Incomplete entry forms must be returned to the designated owner or his authorized agent. Unsigned, telephone, or telegraph entries cannot be accepted, except in the event of a postal strike when telephone entries may be made in accordance with the Canadian Kennel Club Regulations.

FEES / CHEQUES / N.S.F. CHEQUES:

Fees must accompany your entries. Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque or credit cards that have maxxed out shall be considered an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club. There will be a \$35.00 fee charged for any N.S.F. funds issued to the Hub City Kennel & Obedience Club. (Post-dated cheques will be accepted). Overpayment of entry fees will not be refunded.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall *NOT* be included in the calculation for championship points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF WINNERS, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 15.1. In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS, which also places in the regular Group competition, shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

A dog awarded WINNERS which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All-Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 Championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In no case can a dog earn more then five points at a single show.

An error in the class, <u>date of birth or sex</u> may be amended on the entry form up <u>to one hour BEFORE</u> the start of the <u>SHOW</u>.

EXTRACTS FROM THE DOG SHOW RULES BREEDS, CLASSES, AWARDS AND STAKES

12.2.1 Regular Official Classes: All classes must be divided by sex except for Specials Only. Only dogs entered in one of the regular, non-regular, or unofficial classes shall be allowed within the show precincts.

JUNIOR PUPPY: for dogs at least six months of age on the first day of the Show and under nine months of age on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY: for dogs 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show.

12 - 18 MONTH CLASS: for dogs 12 - 18 months on the day of the shows.

<u>CANADIAN BRED</u>: shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions of <u>any</u> country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR: shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the Breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/ breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS: shall be for all dogs.

<u>SPECIALS ONLY</u>: is for dogs which have a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for Championship status <u>including at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level</u>. Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either not to be registered or has not completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be cancelled. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

EXHIBITION ONLY: for Baby Puppies (See **12.2.2** below) and all dogs 6 months or older of age and eligible for registration with the CKC.

MOVING DOGS TO "SPECIALS ONLY": A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for a show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the owner or handler at least 1 hour prior to the opening of the show. NOTE: Class dogs may be moved to "Specials Only" as long as the registration number is on the "Move Up" Sheet.

<u>BEST BRACE IN SHOW:</u> For two dogs of the same breed. Must be handled by one person on one lead. May be spayed or neutered. Will compete for Best Brace in Breed, Best Brace in Group & Show on Sunday. Judged after Best in Breed, after best Puppy in Group and before Best In Show.

<u>BEST VETERAN IN SHOW:</u> For any dogs over 7 years of age. May be spayed or neutered. Will compete for Best Veteran in Breed & Best Veteran in Group on Saturday. Not eligible for Best of Breed. This class is judged after Best of Breed. No points are awarded. See 2013 Dog Show Rules 12.6.1.(b) and 12.1.6 (e)

<u>OBEDIENCE:</u> Classes offered are Novice A & B, Open A & B, Utility A & B, Pre-Novice, Novice C, Novice Intermediate, Exhibition Only. Refund of entry fees is allowed for bitches in season provided a signed certificate is provided from a veterinarian.

RALLY OBEDIENCE: Classes offered are Novice A & B, Advanced A & B, Excellent A & B and Exhibition Only.

CHAPTER 8 - ENTRIES & ENTRY FEES

- **8.8.2** Tendering of a dishonoured cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.
- **8.7.1** Withdrawal of Entries: An Exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry at any time up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by phone, but either written or electronic notification must be received by the show secretary no later than the official closing date. If written notification is not received, the dog will remain entered in the show.

CKC RULES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2009

- **3.3.1** Substitute Judge when an advertised judge will not be able to fulfill his assignment, permission from the CKC to substitute the judge is required.... Exhibitors affected by this change may withdraw their entries up to one hour before the judging of the breed, notice of withdrawal must be made in writing. All entry and listing fees for withdrawn dogs shall be refunded
- **8.2.5**—An error in the age specified class, date of birth or sex of the dog may be amended on the entry form up to ONE hour before the start of the show.
- **8.5.8**—In case of a judge change (substitute or overload) an exhibitor may enter a dog under the replacement judge providing that the dog is entered in one of the regular classes of a show being held at the same venue by the same club

and has been assigned a competition number. A new entry, along with accompanying fees will be accepted by the Show Secretary up to ONE hour PRIOR to the start of the show (see sections 3.3.1, 3.5.1, 8.5.4)

8.9.3—When one or more all-breed and /or Specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to specials MUST be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled **start of the show** for which the dog is being moved up to.

12.3.f —A puppy awarded Best Puppy In Breed is NOT required to compete for Best Puppy in Group.

NON CKC MEMBERS PLEASE NOTE: NEW TRACKING FEE FOR NON-MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC will be instituting a tracking fee for all <u>Canadian</u> residents who participate in a CKC event, but are not CKC members. In order to cover the clerical costs of recording and tracking points and awards earned at a CKC event, a participating non-member can choose to purchase a CKC membership or pay a <u>dog-specific</u> tracking fee (\$55.00). This only applies to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the CKC to efficiently manage recording and tracking points, it's important that non-members select one of the two options within 30 days of notification or, unfortunately, we will be forced to cancel any awards and titles.

To obtain an ERN, simply ...

- Send a photocopy of the dog's Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership with a <u>written request for an</u> ERN number.
- Please indicate coat type and size, if applicable.
- Fee for an Event Registration Number with the CKC is \$57.60 + GST. Include your payment in the full amount in Canadian funds.
- Payment may be made with Visa or Master Card, personal or business cheque or money order. For Non-Members,
 please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non-residents of Canada, please note that
 discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates.
- Provide us with your full return address.
- Faxed requests will be accepted. Please ensure that your Visa or Master Card number is legible and you have included your expiry date and signature.

An ERN must be obtained within thirty (30) days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a thirty (30) day extension.
