Effective January 1, 2011:

- a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$62.40 plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.

THE TYLDESLEY TROPHY (must be Canadian Bred for this award)

Silver-plated Champagne Bucket on a base offered in memory of Susie Mae Weir by the late Douglas Tyldesley Weir, Mary-Jane Tyldesley Weir and Michelle McIntyre for *Best Puppy in Show* providing the puppy is Canadian Bred. If the puppy is not Canadian Bred, then the Trophy will not be offered. Trophy will remain in the custody of The Poodle Club of Canada and Keeper Trophies will be presented to both the owner and the breeder of the puppy.

For each of Standard, Miniature and Toy:

Rosettes are offered for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Awards of Merit, Best Bred By Exhibitor, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Best Puppy, Best of Winners, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Best Baby Puppy and First in each class.

P.C.C. BRONZE MEDALLION

Offered for Best of Breed (Toy, Miniature & Standard) by the Poodle Club of Canada.

Best Bred By Exhibitor - All eligible dogs not directly or indirectly defeated by another eligible dog can compete for this award. All dogs must be breeder/owner-handled throughout the competition.

Award of Merit – At the judge's discretion, Awards of Merit may be awarded up to one Award for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. Rosettes will be given for the Awards of Merit which will be presented following Best of Breed.

EVENT REGISTRATION FEE

Effective Jan. 1/92, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).

The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

Effective January 1, 2011:

- A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$62.40 plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
- Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
- 4. Substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
- 5. ENTRIES POSITIVELY CLOSE 8:00 P.M. TUESDAY, AUGUST 20, 2019 and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.
- Identification cards and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented upon arrival at the show.
- Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any N.S.F. cheques will be subject to a \$20.00 service charge.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- The Poodle Club of Canada, and the Poodle Club of Ontario will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.
- 4. Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging.
- 5. The show venue will be open at 9:00 a.m. Sunday Sept. 1, 2019.
- 6. Judging will not commence before 10. Other times will be specified in the judging schedule.
- Please clean up after your dogs to ensure the grounds are left in proper condition for the community.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5
*includes the dog awarded Winners.						

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge SHALL NOT be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.12. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

CONFORMATION SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. Chapter 4-Section 4.7.3 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

Chapter 8, Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only," providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the judging of your breed by the owner or handler.

When one or more all-breed and/or specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to Specials Only must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the breed judging scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to Specials Only.

SILENT AUCTION

A silent auction will be held at the specialties to help defray the costs.

DONATIONS WELCOME

GRAND CHAMPIONS AND GCH POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Section 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age.

Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level:

Section 15.2.4 The title of Grand Champion shall not be awarded retroactively and all points towards this title must be achieved after the date of January 1, 2013.

GRAND CHAMPION EXCELLENT AND GCHX POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.3.1 The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC grand championship title.

Section 15.3.3 A minimum of 100 points, which must include one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) or a Best in Multiple-Breed Specialty with at least three (3) breeds represented plus three (3) Group 1st or three (3) breed specialty wins.

Grand Champion Excellent point system:

(Note: No points are acquired if no other dog is present in the group.)	
Best of Breed	1
(To earn the breed point, at least five (5) dogs must be shown at breed level.)	
Best in Show or Best in National Specialty Show	10

Section15.3.5 The title of Grand Champion Excellent shall not be awarded retroactively. However, dogs that have been awarded the Grand Champion title prior to January 1, 2013, will be awarded the Grand Cham- pion Excellent title on application to the CKC.

Section 15.3.6 Additional Requirements: To attain a Grand Champion Excellent title, a dog must have been awarded a CKC performance title from any CKC event. A CGN, Herding Tested certificate or Chase Ability Program title are not considered performance titles for the awarding of this title.

ALL SPECIALTY CONFORMATION CLASSES – BOTH SEXES

OFFICIAL CLASSES

Junior Puppy – a dog between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show.

Senior Puppy – a dog between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.

12 – 18 Months – a dog between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show.

Canadian Bred – a dog which is born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

Bred By Exhibitor – dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner <u>and</u> breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The breeder/owner must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

Open Class – for all dogs.

Veterans – for all dogs over seven years of age as of the date of the show. These dogs to compete for the regular placements and the 1st place Dog and Bitch will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

Specials Only – dogs who are Canadian Champions only.

Award of Merit – At the judge's discretion, Awards of Merit may be awarded up to one Award for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. Rosettes will be given for the Awards of Merit which will be presented following Best of Breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Baby Puppy Class – Dogs 3 months of and under 6 months on the day of the show. Both male and female Baby Puppies will be judged prior to the judging of other official classes. Puppies in this category may not compete in any official, unofficial or non-regular classes.

Stud Dog & Get: Entry comprises the Stud Dog and two or more of his Get, ownership in this class need not be identical. Stud Dog may be neutered.

Brood Bitch & Progeny: Entry comprises the Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny, ownership in this class need not be identical. Brood Bitch may be spayed.

Exhibition Only – all dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades.

Each entrant for Stud Dog, or Brood Bitch must be entered in one of the Official Classes in the Specialty or Exhibition Only. All Get and Progeny must be entered in an Official Class.
