Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Important Note Regarding Emails & Faxes

It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules & regulations. Sent fax receipts, and/or, copies of sent emails, will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Junior Puppy	Senior Puppy	12 to 18 Months
Bred by Exhibitor	Canadian Bred	Open
Veterans	Specials Only	Exhibition Only

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (if warranted) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed..

Competition for Sexually Altered Dogs will be offered for sexually altered dogs over six months of age and will be judged after the judging of Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Brace - shall be for two dogs (not necessarily the same sex), the property of the same owner;

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her progeny only

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Parade of Veterans – all dogs must be a minimum of 7 years of age to enter this class. Entrants are requested to provide a brief history of their dog (do not exceed 50 words);

Parade of Title Holders – all dogs must have acquired a title in either conformation, herding or other CKC sanctioned event

Any dogs entered in the following Unofficial Classes must be entered in one of the Regular or Non-Regular classes of this Specialty. Entrants are requested to provide a brief history of their dog (do not exceed 50 words);

Note: All Non-Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your regular entry form.

SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class for Dogs at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months.

Senior Class for Dogs at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months.

12-18 Open for Dogs at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

The winners of all classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes..

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be four classes in all, divided by sex.

7-9 years for Dogs at least 7 years of age up to but not including 10 years

10 to 13 years for Dogs at least 10 years of age up to but not including 13 years

Over 13 years for Dogs 13 years of age and older.

The winners of all classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes..

HERDING DOG SWEEPSTAKES (NOT divided by sex)

Classes offered: Herding Started (HS), Herding Intermediate (HI), Herding Advanced (HA)

Requirements for entry - proof of HS, HI or HA title (i.e. copy of certificate) to be provided to the show secretary with entry. Any dog that does not have a title may be exhibited if proof that the dog has met the requirements of a CKC herding program (i.e. AKC, AHBA or ASCA herding program titles or proof of actual farm/ranch work) is submitted to the show secretary with entry. Dogs may be altered.

For all Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

50% of the entry fees for each sweeps class will go to the winner of each class;

15% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best in Sweeps;

10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps

25% will be retained for administrative purposes.

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. All entries must be received by the closing date and time, accompanied by the proper entry fees and submitted on an official CKC entry form. Please type or print clearly.

2. INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED. Agents and handlers please note that full name and address of owners MUST be filled in and to whom ID's are to be returned.(Section 13.1.2, Dog Show Rules)

3. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.

4. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show/Trials Secretary after the closing time and date.

5. Only dogs eligible for CKC registration may enter these shows. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Building will open at 6:30am each day. On Friday, the Building will be open from 4:00pm until 10:00pm for anyone wishing to set up early.
- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of shows, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- **All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.**
- The ACDCC and Exhibition Park will not be held responsible for any equipment left in the building overnight.
- A canteen will be available in the arena.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that this rule is enforced. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 6.3.3)
- No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 6.3.4)
- The ACDCC and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the KCC and their Show Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.
- "Puppy for Sale" or "Dog for Sale" signs will not be permitted in the building.-
- All rules and regulations as outlined in the Halifax Kennel Club premium list apply to this event.
- **The precincts of the show shall be the entire building and its entrances.**
