THERE IS MAJOR ROAD CONSTRUCTION ON SPRUCE MEADOWS TRAIL, PLEASE WATCH FOR TOURNAMENT LANE SIGNS. ANY DETOURS WILL BE CLEARLY MARKED

- **Downtown Calgary via MacLeod Trail:**
South on MacLeod Trail, then turn west on Spruce Meadows Trail (also known as Hwy 22X/Stoney Trail) and travel approximately 2 km, watch for signs to **Tournament Lane** (turn left here), then follow the signs to AKC RV Parking, North American Entrance or Lot 7.
- **From Edmonton via Deerfoot Trail:**
South on Deerfoot Trail, then turn west on Spruce Meadows Trail (also known as Hwy 22X/Stoney Trail) and travel approximately 2 km, watch for signs to **Tournament Lane** (turn left here), then follow the signs to AKC RV Parking, North American Entrance or Lot 7.
- **From US Border via Highway 2:**
Before reaching the southern city limits of Calgary, turn west on Spruce Meadows Trail (also known as Hwy 22x/Stoney Trail) and travel approximately 2 km, watch for signs to **Tournament Lane** (turn left here), then follow the signs to AKC RV Parking Lot 10, North American Entrance or Lot 7.

Shiba Inu Canada is pleased to be holding their trial at Spruce Meadows. Holding our event here comes with some significant responsibilities for all of us – volunteers and exhibitors alike.

This is a world class Equestrian Centre which welcomes people from around the world and we must treat this venue with the respect it is due.

- Clean up after your dog. KEEP BAGGIES WITH YOU AT ALL TIMES
- Do not allow the male dogs to lift their legs on fences, posts, trees or shrubs

Failure to pick-up after your dogs will result in an automatic expulsion from the show and the show grounds.

1. All parking is at your own risk:
2. No balloons of any sort are permitted on the grounds of Spruce Meadows – they frighten the horses!

Parking:

1. Parking along the east side of E-Barn is permitted only for the duration of the Scent Detection Trial, Thursday, August 1, 2019
2. The speed limit on the grounds of Spruce Meadows is 15 km/hour.
3. Any indignities to the Staff of Spruce Meadows or to the volunteers of Shiba Inu Canada will result in immediate expulsion from the Trials. Thank you for your cooperation!
4. All parking is a privilege at Spruce Meadows. Anyone abusing these privileges will be excused immediately from the show, and all future shows on this venue by the parking authorities and/or show superintendent.

Recycle, Garbage & Dog Poop:

- You are TOTALLY responsible for picking up after your dog. Spruce Meadows and Shiba Inu Canada have ZERO tolerance for dog droppings on the grounds. Let's be responsible and set a great example keeping the grounds pristine. Exhibitors who are found not picking up after themselves will be asked to leave the show immediately.

- All Exhibitors are responsible for putting their recyclables, garbage and hair in the large garbage bins. Please leave your benching areas clean at the end of the show as a courtesy to Spruce Meadows and the volunteers who run the show.

Other Notes:

Please stay within the precincts of the show, there are many weddings and other events occurring over the weekend on the ground, this includes golf carts and photographers.

Balloons are strictly prohibited on the Spruce Meadows grounds, balloons scare the horses, thank you for your understanding in this regard.

Shiba Inu Canada will not be responsible for the loss or injury to any dog, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether a result of accident or any other cause. It is expressly understood that every dog at these shows is in the care, custody, and control of the owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. Exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children.

- **ANIMALS LEFT IN VEHICLES** will be monitored. If animals are in distress due to heat or any other circumstance, the vehicle will be forcibly entered, the animal recovered, and the owner will be subject to penalty under the Animal Protection Act 2(1) (1.1) 2.1©. Shiba Inu Canada will not accept any responsibility for damage to any vehicle entered to remove an animal(s) in distress.

*****NO TRESPASSING AREA*****

The area adjacent to Hwy 22X running east and west and north of the access road in the RV parking area (Lot 10) is totally out of bounds for parking, walking and exercising your dogs this summer. There will be road construction in the area. Spruce Meadows Security and the Alberta Kennel Club will have zero tolerance for infractions of the access ban. Violators of this ban will be excused from the show and the grounds and a fine will be assessed.
