Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary actions and cancellation of awards.

CLASSIFICATIONS

REGULAR CLASSES

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

Baby Puppy	For dogs between 3 months and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. Winners of this class do not compete for points. May be entered provided that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the official regular classes.
Junior Puppy	For dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age
Senior Puppy	For dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age
12-18 Months	For dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months of age one of the regular official classes
Canadian Bred	For dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded
Bred by Exhibitor	For dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder
Open	For all dogs.
Veteran Class	For any dogs 7 years of age and older. The winners of these classes shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. DOGS COMPETING IN THIS CLASS MAY BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED.
Specials Only	Dogs which are <u>Registered Individually</u> in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or have a CKC ERN and have attained championship status may be entered in the "Specials Only" class. Entry of a dog in "Specials Only" is not prohibited on the grounds that the title of champion has not been confirmed by the CKC, but if it is found later that the dog had not attained championship status before the entry had been made, then all awards attained at the show will be cancelled. The entry of a "listed" dog in Specials Only is not allowed.
Best Bred By Exhibitor in Show	To be judged from all dogs entered in the show (including specials). Must be handled by the breeder throughout the entire show.
Sexually Altered Classes	Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been spayed or neutered. Two classes will be offered: Altered Male and Altered Female: Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.
Exhibition Only	For all dogs over 3 months of age and eligible for registration with the Canadian Kennel Club

NON-REGULAR, CLASSES & PARADES

TO COMPETE IN THE JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES CLASS, DOGS MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS OR SPECIALS ONLY. ENTRY IN THE JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES FROM THE EXHIBITION ONLY CLASS IS NOT ALLOWED. DOGS ENTERED IN THE VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES MAY ALSO BE ENTERED IN EXHIBITION ONLY.

All dogs must be entered in the Regular Classes, Veterans, Specials Only, or for Exhibition Only Class to compete in the following non-regular classes. Dogs competing in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

Stud Dog	Stud dog and TWO or more of his Get, not necessarily owned by the same owner. Stud must be entered in a Regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class.
Brood Bitch	Brood bitch and TWO or more of her Progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner. Same rules as Sire & Get.

Brace	For 2 dogs not necessarily of the same sex and not necessarily by the same owner; judged as an identical pair – same color, size, gait, and same stride. Must be handled by one person on one lead.
Stripped Down	For any CKC registered American Cocker Spaniel of any age over 6 months (including neutered or spayed dogs). Length of hair is required to be trimmed to a maximum length of 1 ½ inches long on any portion of the body, with the exception of the ears where no length restrictions apply. Entrants are to be judged on conformation. All males will be judged first as one class, and then all bitches will be judged as the second class. The winners of these two respective classes will compete for Best in Stripped Down. Entrants must be entered in a Regular Class in the Specialty, Obedience Trial, or Exhibition Only to compete in the Stripped Down.
3 Generation	Class entry to be made up of a minimum of 3 generations, each descendent from the Brood Bitch or Stud Dog. (ie: Dogs A, B, C – A is sire or dam of B who is sire or dam of C). Only one representative from each generation is allowed. Dogs must be entered in a regular class or exhibition only. Judge's decision is based on the consistency maintained through multiple generations in a breeding program. Dog A (the grandparent) is the dog entered. First Place only will be awarded in this class. Dogs do not need to be owned or bred by same person. Winner of class is Dog A.
Parade Of Title Holders	Include a short written bio (75 words or less) along with your entry. May be altered and shown in unorthodox trim. Must be entered in an Official event or Exhibition Only.
Parade of Veterans	Same as Title Holders except the dog must be 7 years of age or older.

Cash Prize & Rosettes will be offered for each class as follows:

1st -35 % of entry fee for that class and rosette

2nd -25 % of entry fee for that class and rosette

3rd -15 % of entry fee for that class and rosette

First Place in Each class will compete for Best In Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite to Best in Sweepstakes

Best in Sweepstakes-10 % of total entry plus rosette and prize

Best of Opposite Sex to Best In Sweepstakes-5% of total entry plus rosette and prize

*****NEW TRACKING FEE FOR NON-MEMBERS*****

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC will be instituting a tracking fee for all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event, but are not CKC members. In order to cover the clerical costs of recording and tracking points and awards earned at a CKC event, a participating non-member can choose to purchase a CKC membership or pay a dog-specific tracking fee (\$55.00). This only applies to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the CKC to efficiently manage recording and tracking points, it's important that non-members select one of the two options within 30 days of notification or, unfortunately, we will be forced to cancel any awards and titles.

NOTICE TO ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

To obtain an ERN, simply ...

- Send a photocopy of the dog's Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership with a written request for an ERN number.
- Please indicate coat type and size, if applicable.
- Fee for an Event Registration Number with the CKC is \$57.60 + GST. Include your payment in the full amount in Canadian funds.
- Payment may be made with Visa or Master Card, personal or business cheque or money order. For Non-Members, please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non-residents of Canada, please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates.
- Provide us with your full return address.
- Faxed requests will be accepted. Please ensure that your Visa or Master Card number is legible and you have included your expiry date and signature.

An ERN must be obtained within thirty (30) days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a thirty (30) day extension. GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Saskatoon Kennel & Obedience Club's premium list will also apply to this specialty.
2. Entries will be acknowledged and the judging schedule sent out by the dogshow.ca
3. Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received the Show Secretary no later than the time and date of the official closing. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show and no refund will be made.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall **NOT** be included in the calculation for points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF WINNERS, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this Section.

CLARIFICATION: Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Male shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials Bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must:

- a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges and
- b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN).
- c) have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

The board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean:

- a) 3 or more Winners awards at not less than 3 different shows, under 3 different judges at the breed level.
- b) each of the 3 Winners awards must have earned one or more championship points, not necessarily at the breed level.
- c) all the points required for championship status may be earned at the breed or group level or a combination of both breed and group level.

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour BEFORE the start of the show.
