

Entry Fees

Pre-entry: Includes Canadian Kennel Club Recording Fee

\$22.00 - First Hound

\$20.00 – 2nd and subsequent hound per trial

Post-entry: Includes Canadian Kennel Club Recording Fee

\$35.00 per hound per trial

Other Fees: \$10.00 - For all non CKC registered hounds per entry

\$5.00 – For all unofficial classes (Puppy, Veteran, Kennel, Breeder, Club)

\$10.50 - TCN Fee for each entry without a CKC Per event

Any overpayment of entry frees is considered a trophy donation.

Stakes Offered

Open Stakes: For all hounds including Field Champions.

> Best of Breed, First In Mixed Stakes Best in Field - (Sunday Only)

Veteran Competitive: For all hounds over 7 years of age including Field Champions

Mixed Stakes: Combines breeds with entries of three or less with agreement of all owners. **Veteran Mixed Stake:** Combines breeds with entries of three or less with agreement of all owners.

Official Singles: Limited entry 10 per day. ** Official Singles will not compete in Best in Field**. - Rosette or Ribbon

> If your dog is DQ'd or not ready for running in competition, but you would like your dog judged? This is the place to be! Run individually, over the entire course (both directions) the dog is judged by two judges. No points are awarded and

all ties are settled by a coin toss. Ribbons will be awarded to 1st place to NBQ.

Puppy Sweeps: (6-9 mo) (9-12 mo) (12-18 mo) Run individually.

Breeder Stake: Open to any 2 hounds in the official classes bred by the same person(s) (Saturday Only)

Kennel Stake: Open to any 2 hounds in the official classes owned & kenneled by the same person(s) (Sunday Only)

Eligible Entries

7.1 Eligibility of Hounds

7.1.1 To be eligible to compete at approved lure coursing field trials a dog must meet the following requirements:

(a) A hound must be tested with another dog, of the same breed or a breed with a similar running style (preferably not a kennelmate) and certified running clean by a licensed judge. Hounds must be a minimum of 11 months old prior to being certified, and must run a course of at least 600 yards (548.4 m) in order to be certified.

18 (b) A certificate signed by the judge is given to the owner at the time of the test and must be submitted to the Field Trial Secretary at the dog's

(c) All dogs must be one year of age on the date of the trial to enter a regular stake and must be registered or eligible for registration in the records of the CKC as hereinafter provided.

7.1.2 Any dog who is disqualified/declared ineligible in any lure coursing field trial held under other jurisdictions is ineligible to course.

7.1.3 Listed breeds designated as Sighthounds are eligible to enter provided they have a Miscellaneous

Certification Number (MCN)





Additional Information

- Overnight parking permitted on field. Please park in the designated area
- This is a Federal government site, ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING ON FIELD, Cars only please
- 8.1 It shall be deemed unsportsmanlike conduct if a person, during the running of, or in connection with an event, abuses or harasses a judge, trial official or any other person present in any capacity at the event.
- Port-a-potty on site
- Stakes will be split if the entry is 20 or more hounds at roll call.
- Hounds will be run twice, in braces or trios (except single dog entries) unless excused, dismissed, or declared ineligible
- Lame hounds or bitches in season will be excused and their entry refunded, provided notice is given prior to or during roll
- Hounds not present at roll call shall be scratched with any refunds. No Exceptions
- All handlers must use a slip lead when releasing a hound. A Standing Start will be used on Tally-Ho
- Leg wrappings must be of a neutral colour to comply with CKC rules. Muzzles & catch collars may be used at the handler's discretion. No Flexi-leads or shock collars allowed
- A \$10.00 fine will be assessed for loose dogs on the field after roll call and until after Best in Field
- Bring your own water and shade
- No catalogue will be published. Score sheets will be available
- A veterinary clinic is within easy access to the field. See premium list for available clinics
- Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs. Do not stuff plastic bags down holes. Please use the trash receptacles provided

FIELD TITLES

- 9.6.1 A permanent title of **Field Champion (FCh)** shall be awarded as a suffix to the registered name of any hound which has fulfilled the following requirements:
- (a) Attained 100 championship points in the open or mixed stake competition. (b) Attained 1 first or 2 second placements by defeating dogs in head to head competition.
- 9.6.2 A permanent title of Field Champion Excellent (FChX) will be awarded to the hound which has fulfilled the following requirements:
- (a) Is a Field Champion of Record. (b) Obtains 200 additional points in competition. (c) Attains at least 5 first placements in competition. This ncludes first placements won while attaining an FCh.
- 9.6.3 The Field Champion Excellent title shall be a repetitive title, with a numerical designation. After completing the FCHX title, a hound shall be awarded the next level of title each time it fulfills the requirements of an additional 300 points and 5 first placements with competition. First placements in excess of 5 may be carried forward, and the process shall be indefinitely repeated (FCHX2, FCHX3 etc.).

9.6.4 Novice Courser Title

(a) A designation of Novice Courser (NC) shall be awarded as a suffix to the registered name of any hound which has fulfilled the following requirements: (i) Attain 3 qualifying scores in the open stake under a minimum of 3 different judges.

9.6.6 **Advanced Courser** (29-06-15)

- (a) A designation of Advanced Courser (AC) shall be awarded as a suffix to the registered name of any hound which has fulfilled the following requirements: (i) Attain 10 qualifying scores in the open stake under a minimum of 3 different judges.
- (ii) Scores earned for the Novice Courser title shall count as three of the ten scores required

9.6.7 Advanced Courser Excellent (29-06-15)

- (a) A designation of Advanced Courser Excellent (ACX) shall be awarded as a suffix to the registered name of any hound which has fulfilled the following requirements: (i) Attain 20 qualifying scores in the open stake under a minimum of 3 different judges. (ii) Scores earned for the Advanced Courser title shall count as ten of the 20 scores required (b) The Advanced Courser Excellent title shall be a repetitive title with a numerical designation. After completing the ACX title, a hound shall be awarded the next level of title each time it fulfills the requirements of an additional 20 qualifying scores under 3 different judges. The process shall be indefinitely repeated (ACX2, ACX3 etc.).
- 9.6.8 A permanent title of **Veteran Field Champion (VfCh)** shall be awarded as a suffix to the registered name of any hound which has fulfilled the following requirements: 32 (a) Attained 50 championship points in the Veteran Open Or Veteran Mixed Stake competition. (b) Attained 1 first or 2 second placements against other hounds
- 9.6.9 A permanent title **of Veteran Field ChampionExcellent (VfChx)** will be awarded to the hound which has fulfilled the following requirements: (a) Is a Veteran Field Champion of record. (b) Obtains 50 additional points in competition in the veteran stake. (c) Attains at least 4 first placements in competition. This includes first placements won while attaining a VfCh. 9.6.10 The Veteran Field Champion Excellent title shall be a repetitive title with a numerical designation. After completing the VfChx title, a hound shall be awarded the next level of title each time it fulfills the requirements of an additional 50 points and 4 first placements with competition. First placements in excess of 4 may be carried forward, and the process shall be indefinitely repeated (VfChx2, VfChx3 etc.).
- **9.6.11** (24-12-17) the title of **Single Courser (SNC)** shall be awarded as a suffix to the registered name of any hound which has: (a) Attained 3 qualifying scores in the Singles Stake under a minimum of 3 judges.
- 9.6.12 (24-12-17) the title of Single Advanced Courser (SAC) shall be awarded as a suffix to the registered name of any hound which has:
- (a) Attained 10 qualifying scores in the Singles Stake under a minimum of 3 judges.
- (b) Scores earned for the SNC shall count toward the title count as three of the ten scores required.
- **9.6.13** (24-12-17) **Single Advanced Courser Excellent (SACX)** (a) A designation of Single Advanced Courser Excellent (SACX) shall be awarded as a suffix to the registered name of any hound which has fulfilled the following requirements: (i) Attained 20 qualifying scores in the Singles Stake. (ii) Scores earned for the Single Advanced Courser title shall count as ten of the 20 scores required.
- (b) The Single Advanced Courser Excellent title shall be a repetitive title with a numerical designation. After completing the SACX title, a hound shall be awarded the next level of title each time it fulfills the requirements of an additional 20 qualifying scores under 3 different judges. The process shall be indefinitely repeated (SACX2, SACX3 etc.).

Placements

<u>Chapter 7, Section 1:</u> Championship points are awarded in regular stakes only on the following basis:

1st: 4 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 40 points
2nd: 3 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 30 points
3rd: 2 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 20 points
4th: 1 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 10 points

NBQ: No points

No hound shall receive a placement or points if it does not score at least 50% of the total possible combined scores. If a hound has been **excused** in the preliminary run, that hound shall not count as having been in competition.

Exhibitors please note: As per rule 9.6.1(b) of the CKC Lure Field Trial Rules and Regulations a dog must "Attain 1 first or 2 second placements by defeating dogs in head to head competition". No placements will be awarded towards CKC championships if all dogs in a breed run as singles, but the points will stand.

First Time Entered Hounds (Does not apply to singles competition)

Effective July 1st 1998, hounds entering their first trial in Canada must be tested with another hound, **NOT** a kennel mate, and certified running clean by a licensed judge. The CKC Hound Certification Form **must be completed** and **submitted with the entry at the hound's first trial**. Hounds with the following titles are exempt: ASFA FCh or VFCh, AKC FC or SC, but are still required submitting the Hound Certification Form with their name and exempting titles circled.
