- 1. The club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of these shows, which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- 2. Any dog Excused by the Show Superintendent or Veterinarian for any reason shall not, compete in any class for any awards for the balance of the show.
- **3.** The officials of the show-giving club are responsible for the conduct of the exhibitors and spectators during the show. Any person acting in an objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent (DSR 6.3.3,Jan 98)
- **4.** A judge officiating at a show held under C.K.C. Rules shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the Show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the Show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out. (DSC 6,3.3 Jan 98)
- **5.** There will be no refunds for overpayments of duplicate entries. No entry fees will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- **6.** The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, loss, or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, patrons, or the contents of commercial booths. See agreement on back of entry forms.
