Section 14.7 of the Working Certificate Rule Book “It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving Club to see that a Judge, Club Official or any participant at an Event held under these Rules is not subject to any indignities.

Order of tests: WC’s land and water, WCI’s land and water, WCX land and water.

Entry Fee:

WC/WCI \$55.00 includes HST

WCX \$60.00 includes HST

Entry fee is in Canadian Funds please. No exchange will be given on US funds. A \$11.30 (includes HST) listing Fee must accompany the entry of any dog for which an individual CKC registration or ERN number is not shown.

All owners of unregistered, CKC-recognized breeds entering events are required to obtain a Temporary Competition Number (TCN).

TCNs are replacing the current system of entering events with dogs as “listed”, and allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

- A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event.
- The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN.

A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds with an MCN (Miscellaneous Competition Number) or dogs that will require a PEN (Performance Event Number) or CCN (Canine Companion Number).

TCNs can be obtained:

- Online through CKC’s Portal (Note: Individuals who have not yet used the online Portal will be required to create a Portal account before they can submit a TCN application online);
- By submitting a completed paper application by mail to CKC; or
