**ENTRIES:** Please complete one entry form per dog, per stake, per day in which you wish to enter your dog(s). All entries must contain complete information as required by the CKC rules. All entries must be accompanied by the entry fee in full. All owners of unregistered, CKC recognized breeds entering events are required to obtain a Temporary Competition number (TCN)

**TCN's can be obtained (a) Online through the CKC Portal** (note: Individuals who have not yet used the online Portal will be required to create a Portal account before they can submit a TCN application online.

(b) by submitting a completed paper application by mail to the CKC or

(c) by contacting the Shows and Trials Division of the CKC toll free at 1-855-364-7252

<u>Scratches</u> will be refunded for a bitch in season totally. All other scratches will be refunded at the field trial committee's discretion, other than a fee of \$10.00.

**RULE 21.7 of the Field Trial Rules States:** "It shall be the duty and obligation of the trialgiving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.
