LIMITED ENTRY

Entry in the obedience trials will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 9 Pre-Novice, 8 Novice and Novice Intermediate, 7 Open, and 6 Utility dogs per hour. Entry in the rally obedience trials will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 15 dogs per hour less time for walk-throughs. A judge may not be assigned more than 7 hours of judging. Once a judge has reached his/her capacity, entries for that trial will be closed even if the closing date has not been reached. In the case of the entry limit having been reached, remaining entries will be assigned a position (by class) on a reserve list. Exhibitors will be notified of their position on the reserve list. If the entry of a bitch in season is pulled after entries are closed, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to and including the day of the trial. If the entry of another dog is pulled prior to the trial, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to 24 hours prior to the trial.

FREDA WALLS MEMORIAL TRIALS

Freda Walls was a much loved member of the Hamilton Dog Obedience Club from the early 50's until she passed away in 2011. Over the years, Freda held almost every position in the club and chaired this trial (formerly called the Fall Spectacular) many times. She trained and trialled German Shepherds and a Miniature Poodle and was well known to exhibitors as a very popular obedience judge. We thought that the best way to honour her memory was to name this trial after her. During her lengthy time with us, Freda truly was the backbone of HDOC.

OBEDIENCE PRIZE LIST

All prizes will be awarded for Qualifying Scores only. Winners must be in attendance to receive their prize or it will be forfeited.

The Highest Qualifying Scoring Dog in each trial (HIT) will be awarded a rosette.

Rosettes will be awarded for 1st to 4th in each class.

Pre-Novice will also be awarded rosettes.

Jake Giacomelli Memorial Trophy

Highest combined score in Open and Utility (Same Trial) in either Trial 343 or 346.

Freda Walls Memorial Trophy

Highest combined score in Open and Utility (Same Trial) in either Trial 347 or 350

Howard Ward Memorial Award

Highest aggregate score in Novice in trials 343, 345, 347 & 349

Highest Scoring Veteran (7 years of age or older on the day of the trial) on each day will receive a rosette.

“Completion of Title” rosettes will be given to all teams who complete a title.

RALLY OBEDIENCE PRIZE LIST

All prizes will be awarded for Qualifying Scores only. Winners must be in attendance to receive their prize or it will be forfeited.

Rosettes will be offered for 1st through 4th in each class.

“Completion of Title” rosettes will be given to all teams who complete a title.

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entries close, a Veterinarian's Certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within ten (10) days of the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial, prior to the judging of the class, and the club will refund the entry fees.

CATALOGUES

Catalogues are available on a PRE-ORDER basis only. Those who wish to pre-order at the price of \$5.00 may do so by indicating this on the entry form.

U.S.A. EXHIBITORS

Bank drafts or international money orders in Canadian Funds and personal cheques, payable in U.S. funds, and for the full amount of the entry, will be accepted.

Personally discounted cheques will not be honoured.

Please do not mark personal cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as such items are not cleared through the banks.

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full.
2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees.
3. Telephone/fax/online entries are accepted by The Entry Line at 1-800-293-2935; (fax) 519-754-0796, www.entryline.com.
4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
5. Alterations, substitution or cancellation of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. The entry of a dog in an official class may be changed to another official class within the same trial, The change must be on the appropriate form and submitted to the Trial Secretary by the owner of handler at least 30 minutes before the start of the trial.
6. Only dogs that are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book or are eligible for registration can be entered.
7. The Trial Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
8. **ENTRIES OPEN AT 9:00 am WEDNESDAY AUGUST 28, 2024. ENTRIES POSITIVELY CLOSE WEDNESDAY SEPTEMBER 11, 2024 AT 8:00 pm, OR WHEN THE ENTRY LIMIT IS REACHED, WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST.**
9. Identification cards and judging schedules will be sent as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented to the Trial Secretary upon arrival at the trial.
10. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. **Any NSF cheque will be subject to the current fees charged by the HDOC's financial institution.**

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Trial Chair will be in full charge of the trial, which will be governed by CKC rules.
2. The Hamilton Dog Obedience Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability, in the event of accident or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. A dog shall not be touched without permission of the owner or agent.
3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or complete the trials, no refund of Entry Fees will be made.
4. The trial precincts shall consist of the entire concession building.
5. The venue shall cover the concession building and all adjacent green space and parking areas.

Obedience Rules & Regulations. Chapter 20 Section 20.7

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an obedience or rally trial held under these regulations is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Obedience Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.

Section 3.6.1 of the Obedience Rules and Regulations states: “A judge officiating at a trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the trial. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out.”

Section 8.15.3 “No food, treats or training aids shall be allowed within 3.05m (10ft) of the ring entrance.”

Section 8.16.4 “Collars other than those specified in these rules are not allowed within the venue. Violation of this may result in the removal of the dog from further competition at that trial.”

Section 6.7.4 “No dog entered in the trial will be allowed off leash unless it is in the ring being judged according to the trial rules and regulations.”

MASTER OBEDIENCE TRIAL CHAMPION (MOTCH)

Section 14.3.1 The CKC will permit the use of the letters MOTCH to be used as a prefix of the name of any dog that has met the requirements for that title as hereinafter provided.

Section 14.3.2 Points for this title may only be accumulated after the completion of the OTCH title.

Section 14.3.3 Points may be accumulated simultaneously with credits toward both the OTCHX and MOTCH titles. However, the MOTCH title will not be awarded until completion of the OTCHX title.

Section 14.3.4 One High in Class placement is required in either of the Open B classes or the Utility B class but no minimum score is required.

Section 14.3.5 A dog must acquire a total of 40 points to earn a MOTCH title. A minimum of 15 points must be obtained from either of the Open B classes and the Utility B class. The remaining 10 points can be obtained from either class.

RALLY OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Rally Obedience Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.

Section 17.1 “The requirements for defining and handling unsportsmanlike conduct shall be the same as those listed in the Obedience Trial Rules & Regulations.”

Section 8.15.3 “no food, treats or training aids shall be allowed within 3.05 m (10 ft) of the ring entrance.

Section 8.16.1 “The requirements for leashes, collars and jackets shall be the same as those listed in the Obedience Trial Rules & Regulations.

RALLY CHAMPION (RCH)

Section 16.1 The CKC will permit the use of the letters RCH to be used as a prefix of the name of any dog that has met the requirements for that title as hereinafter provided.

Section 16.2 A dog may begin earning points toward the RCH title as soon as the Rally Master (RM) title requirements have been completed.

Section 16.3 The RCH title will be awarded to dogs that have successfully earned a minimum of 100 points total from competing in both the Excellent B and Master classes in the same trial.

- (a) 50 points must come from the Rally Excellent B class, including a minimum of five (5) scores of 95 or higher.
- (b) 50 points must come from the Rally Master class, including a minimum of five (5) scores of 95 or higher.

Section 16.4 A qualifying score must be earned in both the Excellent B class and the Master class in the same trial on five (5) different occasions under at least five (5) different judges

NEW – CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

1. A non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC.
2. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
3. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
4. All Premium Lists will carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and are not applicable to CKC members.
