Puppy Stake: “A Puppy Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs at least 6 months of age and under 2 years of age on the day of the trial at which the Puppy Stake is judged.” CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations, Chapter 10, section 2

Limit Stake: “A Limit Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs that have not placed in an Open All-Age Stake, or received 2 first placements in any Regular Official Stake (Puppy Stake excepted), at an approved trial in Canada or any equivalent Spaniel trial in any other country. Dogs must be at least 6 months of age on the day of the trial.” CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 3. There must be a minimum of 4 starters or the stake will be cancelled.

Amateur All-Age: “An Amateur All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for all dogs at least six months of age on the day of the trial at which the stake is judged. A person shall be considered an amateur if he has not attempted to receive any part of his livelihood from the training, handling or showing of field trial or hunting dogs in the calendar year of the trial or the preceding calendar year. Dogs running an Amateur Stake must be owned by an amateur and handled by an amateur.” *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 5.* There must be a minimum of 12 starters or the stake will be cancelled.

Open All-Age: “An Open All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for all dogs at least six months of age on the day of the trial at which the stake is judged. *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 4.* There must be a minimum of 12 starters or the stake will be cancelled.

Water Test - A Spaniel is primarily a land dog. However, in many parts of the country he is used to retrieve waterfowl, and in an ordinary day's shoot there are occasions when the only way of gathering shot game is after a swim or from a stream, pond or lake. *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 16, section 1.* 16.3.5 a Field Trial Committee may host a “**stand alone**” water test to be judged on a pass/fail basis provided such information has been outlined in the premium list and approved by the CKC.

Novice Stake - shall be for dogs at least 6 months of age on the day of the trial (with no age limit) that have not placed in an All Age Stake.

SDKC is a member in good standing with the CNSFTA, placements in all age stakes qualify for the corresponding National as well as CNSFTA high point awards.

Points: Championship Points are awarded for placements in the All-Age Stakes, provided that there are 10 or more starters. Points awarded as follows:

1st Place - 5 Points, 2nd Place - 3 Points, 3rd Place - 2 Points, 4th Place - 1 Point

AWARDS

Standard CKC Rosettes to all placing dogs in each stake. Keeper plaque for all winners, CKC certificate for successful completion of water test. Open - Windbourne Challenge Trophy Limit – Esten Electric Challenge trophy

Indignities and Unsportsmanlike Conduct:

CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations:

21.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, field trial marshal, volunteer, gunner or competitor at a field trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair **shall** promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

It shall be deemed unsportsmanlike conduct if a person during the running of or in connection with an event abuses or harasses a judge, trial official or any other person present in any capacity at the event.

Any handler who displays unsportsmanlike conduct or who is seen to kick, strike or otherwise roughly manhandle a dog while on the grounds of a Spaniel field trial at any time during the holding of the event, **may be expelled from the trial by the Spaniel Field Trial Committee.**

10.7.1 A Novice Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs at least 6 months of age on the day of the trial (with no age limit) that have not placed in an All-Age Stake.

10.7.2 Dog running in Amateur stakes must be owned by an amateur and handled by an amateur (in accordance with the rules 10.5.2). Dogs that are owned, either in whole or in part, by a professional are excluded from entry in CKC approved Novice

Non-member participation fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members".

Attention US Handlers: To apply for TCN or ERN # follow the following steps: 1. Go to ckc.ca, 2. login, 3. create an account, 4. I only want to set up a portal account, 5. TCN registration.
