If entering both tests each day, select a single time slot (i.e. Early pm OR Late pm). The running order will be cycled through twice to give dogs a break between runs. You will receive your time block a few days before the event, after entries are closed.

### CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB INFORMATION

### NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE POLICY

Effective January 1, 2011

a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$59.40, plus applicable taxes. b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld. d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

#### **EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)**

Effective January 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This ERN does not register a dog for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with a cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$64.00, plus taxes.

#### MIXED AND UNRECOGNIZED BREEDS

These events are open to mixed and unrecognized breeds. In order to compete, mixed and unrecognized breed dogs must have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) from the Canadian Kennel Club and must have a CKC-approved microchip. Mixed-breed dogs must be spayed or neutered. Unrecognized breed dogs do not need to be spayed or neutered. A dog eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC studbook it may be entered as a listed dog per CKC rules for this designation, as of July 1, 2018; exhibitors must apply to the CKC for "temporary competition number (TCN), before event closing date". ### TITLES SHALL BE AWARDED ON THE BASIS OF THE FOLLOWING:

Three titles will be awarded for dogs that pass the Chase Ability Program test the required number of times. For purebred dogs, these are suffix titles that will appear on a dog's pedigree with a higher-level title superseding a lower level title.

1. *Chase Ability (CA)* – Awarded to a dog that passes the Chase Ability test three times under at \*least two different judges.\*

2. *Chase Ability Excellent (CAX)* – Awarded to a dog that passes the CA test a total of 10 times (CA + 7 additional passes).

3. *Chase Ability Excellent 2 (CAX2)* – Awarded to a dog that passes the CA test a total of 20 times. A higher number title will be awarded for every ten (10) passes.

\*NEW\* \*As of January 1, 2024, dogs 7 years old or older may enter Chase Ability Tests as a

**Veteran (OPTIONAL).\*** The entry form must identify a dog being entered as a veteran. The dogs shall run half of the regular course for their height/type category.

4. *Veteran Chase Ability (VCA)* – Awarded to a dog that passes the Veteran Chase Ability test three times under at **\*least two (2) different judges.\*** 

5. *Veteran Chase Ability Excellent (VCAX)* – Awarded to a dog that passes the Veteran CA test a total of 10 times (VCA + 7 additional passes).

6. *Veteran Chase Ability Excellent 2 (VCAX 2)* – Awarded to a dog that passes the Veteran CA test a total of 20 times. A higher number title will be awarded for every ten (10) passes.

Awards and Prizes: Qualifiers will receive flat ribbons. Rosettes will be provided for dogs achieving a title during these events.

### **ELIGIBILITY, COURSES & CONDITIONS**

### **ELIGIBLE BREEDS:**


Chase Ability Program participation is open to all purebred and mixed breed dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the CKC; or have an Event Registration Number (ERN); or have a Performance Event Number (PEN); or eligible for registration with the CKC; or have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed; or have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it's a mixed breed. Dogs with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Females in season may not enter. A dog may enter only once per event. Dogs run as singles.

### **COURSE PLANS:**


The club reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the test.

\*NEW\* \*As of January 1, 2024, dogs under 14" shall be eligible to run the 300 yard course (changed from under 12")\*

Saturday (~600 yards; 300-yard and 150-yard courses indicated):

### 150-YARD COURSE:

The 150-yard course is for Veteran dogs shorter than 14 inches at the withers and Veteran brachycephalic ("flat-faced") dogs.

### **300-YARD COURSE:**

The 300-yard course is for dogs shorter than 14 inches at the withers, brachycephalic ("flat-faced") dogs, and Veteran dogs 14 inches and taller at the withers.

#### 600-YARD COURSE:

The 600-yard course is for all dogs that do not run the 150 or 300-yard course. If there is a question as to which course a dog will run, the judge will decide.

#### **CONDITIONS:**

All dogs will run individually. Slip leads are recommended when starting your dogs. Muzzles may be used at owner's discretion. Dogs not present at roll call shall be scratched with no refunds.

#### **NO EXCEPTIONS:**

Lame dogs or bitches in season during roll call will be excused and their entry fees refunded.

### **DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL:**

## PLEASE BE CAUTIOUS WITH GPS & GOOGLE MAPS. REFER TO THESE DIRECTIONS TO CONFIRM YOU ARE NOT BEING TAKEN THROUGH THE WOODS (if you exit the 102 at Stewiacke, you will likely be travelling a rough dirt road for a significant distance).

### From NB & YONDER:

Take Trans Canada highway 104. PLEASE NOTE TOLL HIGHWAY (\$4 for cars). Take exit 15 for highway 102 at Truro. Take exit 12 at Brookfield. Follow the ramp to the right. Proceed straight at lights. Drive 22km approximately. Turn right onto Cloverdale Road. In 500m, turn left onto South Branch Road. At the stop sign, turn left onto Ridge Road. Trial is on the right, turn in just after the little bridge and before the house.

#### FROM HALIFAX:

Take highway 102. Take exit 12 at Brookfield. Follow the ramp to the right. Proceed straight at lights. Drive 22km approximately. Turn right onto Cloverdale Road. In 500m, turn left onto South Branch Road. At the stop sign, turn left onto Ridge Road. Trial is on the right, turn in just after the little bridge and before the house.

#### FIELD CONDITIONS:

- Large field, away from paved roads
- Field is NOT fenced
- No shade on field, bring your own, as well as drinking water
- Please only park where directed

### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

• Dogs will run once per test, but twice per time slot (if entered in both tests). You are responsible for reading the club waiver (attached) which you will **electronically sign** with your online entry. Anyone you bring must complete a paper waiver and bring it to the tests (or email it to <u>eastcoastsighthound@outlook.com</u> beforehand). You are responsible for checking your own Qs/legs and knowing if your dog has achieved any titles. Your dog's Qs/legs (earned \*after\* August 28, 2019) are now available on your CKC online portal. You are responsible for tracking your dog's qualifying runs and under which judges they were earned. \*Your dog must earn **3 qualifying runs under 2 different judges** to earn their CA or VCA title.\*

• There will be a **Title Log sheet** at the main check-in table to record any titles your dog has earned that weekend if you would like us to include them in our event wrap-up on the ECSA Facebook page.

• Dogs are expected to be aroused and excited in the presence of the lure, but handlers must be able to control their dogs for everyone's safety or they shall be refunded their entry and not allowed to run. Additionally, the event committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.

• You will need to crate your dog in/by your car. There will be no shade provided so please keep your dog cool by keeping windows open, using shade cloths, and providing fresh water (please bring your own).

**Important Notes:** This is a PRIVATE residence, and we are grateful for the use of this location. Please respect instructions, pick up after and maintain control of your dog. **Retractable leads, prong collars, and electronic collars are not allowed on the premises. Owners may have their dog wear a muzzle, if they desire. Dogs may run "naked" or wear a flat, snug-fitting buckle catch collar with nothing hanging from it that can become entangled in the line. You may walk your dog to the start line in a martingale, slip collar or harness, but it <b>MUST be removed prior to releasing them.** There is a risk of injury for all active sports; you can reduce this risk by warming up and cooling down your dog, only running your dog when you feel the field and weather are appropriate and staying aware of your environment and any safety hazards. A \$10 fine, payable to ECSA, will be levied for any dog loose on the field from the time of inspection until the completion of all events for the day. A \$10 fine, payable to ECSA, will be levied for any exhibitor not picking up after their dog. Events run rain or shine.
