Judges Biographies

Katrina Santas - I grew up owning an Australian Cattle Dog of working lines which started my interest in the canine world. I began showing dogs in 1997; my first show breed which is still my focus is the Keeshond. Since then I have also shown and bred Champion Boxers and Whippets (and sparingly shown Hungarian Vizsla's, Dalmatians and German Spitz). I have also handled many other breeds in all groups over the years. I have bred and/or owned and titled over 80 Keeshonds to Champion, Grand Champion and Supreme Champions in the USA, Canada, UK, NZ and Australia - most with multi BIS, BIG and BISS show wins. In Boxers the same can be said for 8 of the breed and 2 in Whippets. Formerly breeding under the Calivale prefix and now Hunkeedori Keeshonds, I have been Australia's # 1 Keeshond breeder and exhibitor for many years. My employed career is also extensively involved as I am the National Endorser Manager - Breeders for Nestle Purina PetCare in Australia where I sponsor Australia's largest dog shows including the prestigious Sydney Royal Easter Show; provide lectures to breeders, kennel staff and government agencies on canine nutrition, breeding, disease prevention and diet; and have developed an extensive breeder loyalty program for Purina Pro Plan breeders.

Gladys Gates - Gladys Gates became involved with purebred dogs in May of 1977 when she received a Keeshond puppy as a Mother's Day gift from her husband and two children. After much coaxing from the breeder, she entered Chinook in his first show in September of that year and he became a Canadian Champion at the young age of **8 1/2 months**, owner-handled. The seed was planted and he and Gladys had lots of fun in the show ring. He won his first Best In Show on "Mother's Day" in May 1980 after winning Best of Breed at the Keeshond Club of Canada's Keeshond Booster. Gladys also tried her hand at Obedience and Chinook received his CD degree in three straight trials with excellent scores. After acquiring a lovely female from Ontario, Gladys decided to try her hand at breeding. Her first litter, born in September 1981, produced **Ch. Seawind's Lit'I Bit O'Wrock CD**, a multi-Best In Show winner and High in Trial winner. Over the years, she has accumulated 30 plus Best In Shows on her dogs, all **owner-handled**. In 2002, her **Ch. Seawind's Sunshine Man** was the **Top Keeshonden in Canada**. She has watched Sunny's offspring excelling in conformation, Obedience and Rally. Gladys has bred some of Canada's top winning Keeshonden both in conformation and obedience.

Stateside, Gladys has also enjoyed judging Puppy Sweepstakes at the **Heritage Trail Keeshond Club Specialty** in 1986 in Ashland, Mass and the **Buckeye Keeshond Club Specialty** in 1998 in Cleveland, Ohio. In April 2002, Gladys was honored to be invited to judge the Puppy and Veteran Sweepstakes at the **Keeshond Club of America National Specialty** in Frederick, Maryland and in 2012, Gladys was honored once again when asked to judge the **Top Keeshond Event** at the **Keeshond Club of America National Specialty** in conjunction with the **Mount Hood Keeshond Club**.

At home, in Nova Scotia she has judged Puppy and Veteran Sweepstakes at the **Norwegian Elkhound Specialty** in 1999, the **Golden Retriever and Labrador Retriever Specialties** in 1997 and 2001, the **Flat Coat Retriever Sweepstakes** 2001, the **Maritime Group Seven Specialty** Puppy Sweepstakes in 2004, the **First Atlantic Top Puppy Awards** in 2000 and the first **Atlantic Top Dog and Top Puppy Awards** in 2008 in conjunction with the Island Dog Club on Prince Edward Island. In 2010, Gladys again judged the **Atlantic Top Dog and Top Puppy Awards** at the **Island Kennel Club** and 2014 at the **Moncton Kennel Club**.
