A Bit About the Judges



Pam McClintock, Welland, ON

I have been involved in the sport of dogs for over 42 years. I breed Bullmastiffs and French Bulldogs. As a professional handler I have handled BIS and BPIS dogs in all 7 groups as well as many specialty winners in various breeds. Through the years I have been involved with a kennel club at the executive level as well as directing the Canadian Professional Handlers Association as president. I have taught handling classes for numerous clubs both here and in the US. I have conducted private handling seminars and currently I teach weekly handling classes throughout the year.

I enjoy judging and have judged all breed puppy sweepstakes as well as being privileged to judge puppy and veteran sweeps and futurity at Bullmastiff specialties in Georgia, Texas, Pennsylvania, Oregon, Louisiana and Surrey, BC, these last two being National specialties. I am a life member of the CKC and longtime member of the American Bullmastiff Association.



Robin L. Stansell, Clayton, NC

Mr. Stansell first exhibited Bulldogs in 1976 and joined the Bulldog Club of Northern California. His military career stations permitted him to exhibit in both the United States and in Europe. He was first approved to judge in 1990 and has judged throughout the United States, as well as, Mexico, Columbia, Venezuela, Chile, Brazil, Costa Rica, Sweden, France, China, Korea and Japan. He is an approved BCA Judges Education presenter and breed mentor. He judged Bitches at the 1995 National Specialty and Dogs at the 1990 National Specialty and Best of Breed at the 2012 National Specialty. Although he is approved to judge all Non-Sporting breeds and permit approval to judge all Working Breeds, Bulldogs are his first love. Robin has primarily competed in conformation but he has also completed CD and CDX titles on Bulldogs. His experience at AKC includes 11 years as an Executive Field Representative and as Vice President of Event Operations.

Robin and his wife, Cindy, currently share their lives with three Bulldogs, two French Bulldogs, three Finnish Spitz, four Siberian Huskies, and a Great Dane.



Jack Segall, Bloomfield, MI

Jack's life journey to the of judging bulldogs began when his wife, Shelly, brought her dog, a boxer, into his life. That dog begot another and that one begot another and another until they had enough money to buy their first Bulldog. Thus began the Do-Bee Bulldog line that has now filled their house with dogs. While their children were still living at home, Shelly and he finished 27 champions traveling 100,000 miles in a motor home with the first one purchased the weekend before their first champion finished. That number has since increased to 36, with 27 of them home bred. Over the years they have had 65 bulldogs share their house, many who lived twelve or more years.

Their four children have also multiplied to 11 grandchildren, all champions! Jack's enjoyment of the dogs is second only to the fun of the grandkids.

Jack and Shelly have lived in the Detroit area for over 40 years. Both are active in the Detroit Bulldog Club, with Jack currently serving as President. Jack teaches conformation dog handling classes through their local school system community outreach program.
