Important Information

- Doors will open at 12pm Saturday and 10am Sunday. Parking is in the angled permit parking lot in front of the main doors (with all the flags.) Enter the main doors and the gym is on your right.

- If you are registered for the workshop Friday evening, please ensure you arrive by 4pm to assist with ring set up. If we do not have enough hands to assist with ring set up, then we may run behind schedule, and we will not be able to run the workshop for the full four hours. Your trial committee all have their own jobs to do to ensure the trial and workshop runs as smoothly as possible and cannot be solely responsible for ring set up.

- Please be prepared to stay after your class Sunday afternoon to assist with ring tear down. We understand that everyone is tired and just wants to go home after their class on Sunday, but if we do not have enough hands to assist with tear down then we may be unable to offer these trials in the future. Your trial committee will have been on site all day both days of the trial and cannot be solely responsible for ring tear down.

- Please contact Debbie Hollohan if you can assist with loading up the equipment at Buckmaster Circle Rec Center Friday afternoon, or with unloading the equipment back at Buckmaster after the trial on Sunday.

- Day of Trial entries for will be accepted up to one hour before the start of each trial. Entries may be paid in cash (exact change only) or by EMT to nkctreasurer@gmail.com with confirmation code provided to the Trial Secretary. Day of Trial entries are \$45 per run and \$25 per day for Exhibition Only. Please submit entries for Sunday before you leave on Saturday if possible.

- Changes of Entry (Move Ups) will be accepted up to one hour before the start of each trial. Please submit changes for Sunday before you leave on Saturday if possible.

- Crates and crate covers are strongly recommended for all dogs.

- It is of extreme importance that everyone is vigilant about ensuring their dogs are not peeing or pooping inside the building, nor against the outside of the building or too close to any entrances. Easy way to remember is to not allow your dog to pee on anything "man-made." If you see any poop, please pick it up, even if it's not yours – in Agility we call this "Adopt-a-Poop!" These issues are the #1 reason that clubs lose access to these facilities, as we just did this past fall. The Marine Institute is a beautiful facility and they have been gracious enough to allow us to use their space for these trials, so please do not allow your dog to do anything that may prevent us from using this space in the future. Anyone seen not picking up poop or allowing their dog to pee on the building or near the entrances may be ejected from the trial without refund and have their future entries rejected. There are tons of green spaces away from the building for potty breaks.
