US Cheques will be accepted in US funds at par. NSF cheques shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A collection fee of \$30.00 will be added to the amount of any returned cheque. Telephone entries are not accepted by the Trial Secretary. Incomplete entries, entries received without fees and entries received after the advertised closing date will be subject to same day fees if available. There will be no refund on overpayments or duplicate entries.

DIRECTIONS TO SHEEP THRILLS FARM - Located approx. 15 minutes from Saskatoon.

Head west on 22nd Street and onto Hwy 14. Turn left (south) at the Sandyridge Gas Station onto Young Road. Go 1 mile to the stop sign, turn right (west) onto the paved road. Go about 1 mile; Sheep Thrills is the last place on the right hand side just before the train tracks. There is a gate (with dogs on it) across the drive, open it up and come on in, please close it behind you. Sheep Thrills Farm can be found on Google Maps.

Accommodation Info: There is free on site camping (tents, campers, RVs), sorry no hook ups. A pet friendly hotel that is close by is the Best Western Plus Blairmore in Saskatoon www.bestwesternblairmore.com Check out www.expedia.ca for more options and rates.

PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG!! Dogs must be on leash when not in the arena or the designated exercise area. There is livestock on the premises, so please control your dog, close any gates behind you if you find them closed, and leave them open if you find them open. Thank you!

Non-Member Participation Fee: An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charge to a Canadian non-member of the CKC. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: ERN numbers must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded from the CKC website: <http://www.ckc.ca>

Section 18.1 of the CKC Herding Rules states: The CKC shall not be responsible to any member, person, partnership, club or corporation for any loss, damage or injury arising at or by reason of any herding trial held under any rules adopted by the CKC.

Section 15.7 of the CKC Herding Rules states: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club officer, ring steward volunteer or competitor at a herding trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Herding Trials Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.
