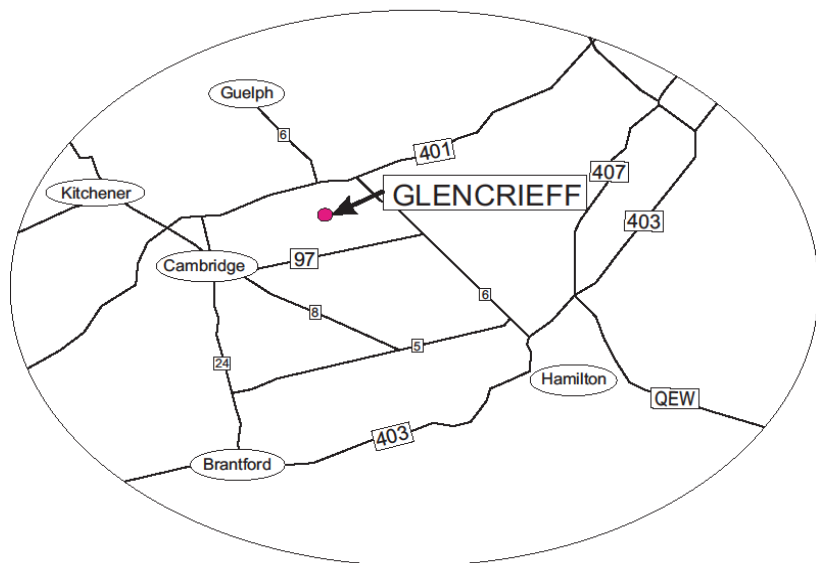

Zero Tolerance Policy

The Labrador Owners Club is a volunteer organization, dedicated to the improvement and well being of the Labrador Retriever. The LOC organizes, promotes, and offers to LOC members and members of the public, events that showcase the talents of the handlers and their dogs. We strive to promote good sportsmanship among all participants and spectators at each of our events.

Please be Advised:

The Labrador Owners Club has ZERO tolerance for abuse (or harsh handling) of any kind to any person or animal present at any of our events. This includes, but is not limited to, judges, organizers, volunteers, competitors, animals, and members of the public.

Failure to comply could result in immediate removal from the event and the site, up to and including a permanent ban from any and all future Labrador Owners Club events. The decision to remove from an event is at the discretion of the LOC event organizers present in consultation with members of the LOC Executive. A permanent ban will be determined after a thorough review of the incident by the LOC Executive. The person under review will be advised of the final decision upon completion.

TEST DETAILS:

- Standard CKC rosettes awarded to all qualifying dogs
- Ribbons will be given out at the end of each stake
- Ducks will be used for land and water, pheasants for upland
- Shotguns may not necessarily be used
- Hunt test handlers shall be attired in dark or customary hunting attire.

- Requests refunds will be given for bitches in season. A Veterinarian certificate must be submitted prior to test
- Requests for refunds for injuries sustained after the closing date of test must accompany a letter from a veterinarian and be received before the day of the test
- Recommended arrival time is ½ hour prior to the start time for each stake.
- Entrants may be required to help with gunning and other volunteer positions required in the running of the test.

The Labrador Owners Club is a member in good standing with the Canadian National Master Retriever Club. As of July 1, 2010 only passes at Hunt Tests hosted by clubs in good standing of the Canadian National Master Retriever Club are considered in determining eligibility to enter the National Master Hunt Test Stake.

All owners of unregistered, CKC-recognized breeds entering events are required to obtain a *Temporary Competition Number (TCN)*.

TCNs are replacing the current system of entering events with dogs as “listed”, and allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

- A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event.
- The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN.
- A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds with an MCN (Miscellaneous Competition Number) or dogs that will require a PEN (Performance Event Number) or CCN (Canine Companion Number).

- [Online](#) through CKC’s Portal (Note: Individuals who have not yet used the online Portal will be required to create a Portal account before they can submit a TCN application online);

Excerpt from the CKC Rules & Regulations for Hunt Tests (section 2.5)

2.5.2: Electronic collars (either dummy or live) as well as prong/pinch type collars shall not be worn by a dog on the grounds of a Hunt Test at any time during the event with the exception of those collars designed to curtail barking which may be worn by a dog while kenneled.

Excerpt from the CKC Rules & Regulations for Hunt Tests (section 3.8)

3.8.1: A judge officiating at a hunt test held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the hunt test. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the hunt test to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
