No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.

The Lady Slipper Kennel Club will only accept entries through the Dogshow.ca program, and by mail or hand to the show secretary. Entries through any other professional entry service will not be accepted.

Official CKC Entry Forms MUST be used. All entries must be received on or before the closing date & time. PLEASE PRINT OR TYPE YOUR ENTRIES. Remember your entry can only be as accurate as the information you provide. The Show Secretary is NOT RESPONSIBLE for incorrect information provided by the entrant. Please read your entry carefully before you submit it. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the errors were made. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC Rules. Photocopy extra Entry Forms if required. If a dog is entered in more than one class or even a separate entry form is required for each one. Generic entry form is available on dogshow.ca and canuckdogs.com

#### **NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE**

A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a "non-member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to Canadian Kennel Club members.

NO POST DATED CHEQUES ACCEPTED. ALL NSF cheques are subject to a charge of \$35.00. N.S.F. cheques are considered Non-Payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the shows/trials. Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US Funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable In Canadian Funds" or "At Par", they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge you to purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

**INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED.** Agents and handlers please note that the **full name and address of owners MUST be filled in** and to whom ID's are to be returned. (Section 13.1.2 Dog Show Rules)

#### CONFORMATION CLASSES

Baby Puppy	A dog 4 months up to 6 months on the day of the show.
Junior Puppy	A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show.
Senior Puppy	A dog 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show.

12-18 Months A dog between 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show.

**Canadian Bred** A dog 6 months of age or older which was born in Canada.

**Bred by Exhibitor** A dog 6 months of age or older owned and handled by the breeder.

Open Class A dog 6 months of age or older Specials Only Dogs who are Canadian Champions.

**Altered** A dog 6 months of age or older who has been spayed or neutered by

veterinary procedure

**Rules and Regulations** The exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.

**Exhibition Only** Dogs 6 months of age and over not in competition. Dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months on the day of the show not in competition may be entered in Exhibition Only providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the Regular official classes. No exhibitor may enter more than 2 puppies.

#### **CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS**

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERs shall be as follows:

A dog awarded Best In Show at an All Breed Championship Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show. **NOTE: In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall <u>NOT</u> be included in the calculations of Championship Points.** 

#### **GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS**

Grand Champion (GCh) The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh:

(c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points. (d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Bronze (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

**Grand Champion Silver (GChS)** The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which

must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

# Dog Placed

Grand Champion Gold: (GChG) The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website. To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special: (a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) (b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins. (c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles, (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career. NOTE: 1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward to CKC upon completion of requirements above. 2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until July 1, 2022.

# **ALTERED CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS**

13.8 Champions & Championship Points

13.8.1 Championship points will be awarded as per Chapter 15 (above), with the exception of 15.1.11. The winner of an Altered Best in Show shall be awarded points according to the total number of dogs in competition following the point schedule in Section 15.1.2.

#### **CONFORMATION SHOW PRIZES**

Suitable rosettes & prizes will be offered each show for Best In Show, Reserve Best In Show, Best Puppy In Show, Best Baby Puppy In Show, & Best Altered in Show. Rosettes will be offered for Group  $1^{st}-4^{th}$  and Best Puppy in Group, Best Altered in Group & Best Baby Puppy In Group. Best of Breed and all other class placings will receive Flat Ribbons

**COMMUNICABLE DISEASES** - Entry Fees will be refunded for dogs/bitches that are posing a threat of a COMMUNICABLE DISEASE on the day of the show. To obtain the refund a letter from a practicing Veterinarian MUST be presented to the Show Secretary prior to the commencement of the show/trial.

#### PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it: 1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease; 2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event); 3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease. Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1. The Show Superintendent will be in complete charge of these events, which are governed by the CKC rules.
- 2. Show and trial precincts are the building and the entrances to it.
- 3. To comply with regulations NO SMOKING OF ANY KIND WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE BUILDING OR WITHIN 15 FEET OF THE ENTRANCES.
- Exhibitors are responsible for ensuring that they are entered in the correct class.
   Please refer to the CKC rule book.

- 5. Dogs should be on standby at their respective areas 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging. Judges are not required to wait for late arrivals and will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. There will be no PA system used to call dogs to the ring. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to advise that a dog is absent.
- All exhibitors will be held responsible for CLEAN-UP on the show grounds and surrounding areas, for their own dogs or dogs they are handling. Additionally, CLEAN-UP after your dog(s) at your motel or campground. PLEASE FOLLOW THIS RULE SO THAT OUR CAMPGROUND AND MOTEL PRIVILEGES ARE NOT REVOKED.
- 7. The Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 8. The Lady Slipper Kennel Club will not be responsible for equipment left at the show site overnight.
- 9. The building will open 1 hour before the start of each day's shows. Dogs will not be permitted in the building overnight. **No vehicles permitted inside the building.**
- The Lady Slipper Kennel Club reserves the right to limit individual exhibitor space inside the building.
- Building management reserves the right to manage the air-cooling system inside the building.
- 12. Please be advised that camping or setting up in the parking lot is strictly prohibited. We appreciate your understanding and co-operation
- 13. In addition, access to the dressing rooms is strictly prohibited.
- 14. Building will be open from 4-8:00 pm on Friday evening for setup.
