To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Show Secretary after that date and time.

BRANTFORD & DISTRICT KENNEL CLUB COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOL

IF YOU CANNOT COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING RULES <u>DO NOT ENTER</u> <u>OR ATTEND</u>

THERE WILL BE A ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY ON FAILURE TO FOLLOW COVID-19 POLICIES INCLUDING NOT WEARING A MASK OR SOCIAL DISTANCING WHENEVER POSSIBLE. FOLLOWING ONE WARNING, OFFENDERS WILL BE BANNED FROM THE BUILDINGS.

Building Access:

Upon Arrival: Report to the East door of the Concession Building to deliver waiver(s) and receive admittance wrist band (will be provided at this time only). Armbands should be picked up at this time.

Entry to the Concession (Show) Building:

When entering the Concession Building, each individual will have to answer a series of questions regarding COVID19 that have been set by the Ontario Government. Each individual will undergo an infa-red temperature check. Failure to pass the questionnaire or temperature check will result in denial of entry to the building.

NOTE: There will be VERY few exhibitors allowed to groom in the Concession Building. **All grooming sites in the Concession Building will be pre-assigned.** A maximum of three (3) individuals will be allowed at any grooming site in this building. All other exhibitors shall groom in the Grooming Building (Old Macdonald's Farm) - space permitting.

Grooming Building (Old Macdonald's Farm building): Entry to the Grooming Building shall be granted only with an admittance wristband. Entering shall be by the East door and exiting shall be by the West door. A maximum of two individuals will be allowed at any grooming site in this building.

Showing: Access to the Concession Building to exhibit your dog shall be via the South entrance to the Concession Building (see ring protocol below).

Waiver:

Must be signed by Club Members, Judges, Ring Stewards, Exhibitors, Owners, Handlers, Breeders, Assistants and Volunteers. Contact tracing information must be provided for all who attend (name & phone number).

Masks: MANDITORY

Must be worn correctly over mouth and nose by ALL individuals in the Concession Building or the Grooming Building, in Washrooms, in any other location where 2 meters - 6ft cannot be maintained.

Social Distancing: (2 meters-6ft) MANDITORY

In the rings, inside both buildings, adjacent ring areas, at the Show Secretary Table/Set-up and at the Photographers booth.

Ring Protocol:

Show scheduling will be quite rigid so that there is little chance to miss a ring time. Group judging times will also be scheduled. Dogs required for judging will enter through the South door and proceed directly to the assigned ring.

Each ring will have an Entrance, an Exit and Social Distancing Markers. Exhibitors will pick up their placement ribbons as they exit the ring. NO RECYCLING of ribbons. If you do not want the ribbons, do not accept them.

Upon completion of the respective breed judging, exhibitors will immediately return to their grooming site. Exit from the Concession Building shall be by the East door.

The Club will provide hand sanitizing stations. There will be a "limited" supply of masks in case someone needs one.

Grooming tables used in the ring will be cleaned frequently.

"Wash your Hands, Wash your Hands"

(Stay in your Bubble)

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The buildings are not open to spectators. This includes **<u>any</u>** individuals not actively showing a dog.

Blow dryers shall not be used in either building.

Exercise pens are not allowed in the buildings.

DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE BUILDINGS OVERNIGHT. Both buildings will be open at 7:00 am and close one hour after Best in Show on Friday and Saturday evenings.

Crates and trolleys are not allowed at ringside. A ringside table may be set up at ringside immediately prior to the respective breed judging but must be removed when breed judging is completed.

Due to limitations on numbers allowed in each building, exhibitors are requested to leave the respective building once they have completed showing for the day. ALL equipment must removed from the Grooming Building when leaving for the day. Equipment left in the Grooming Building will be removed at the owners risk. Sites in the Grooming Building shall not be "saved" from day to day.

There are no food facilities on the Fairgrounds. Exhibitors should bring their own food. Information on food facilities close to the Fairgrounds will be provided.

No public dog bathing station.

Be self-sufficient: bring sanitizer, bring personal use masks.

Do not leave personal belongings at ringside. Do not leave masks, gloves, water bottles, litter, etc. behind, dispose of these items in the garbage bins.

Avoid shaking hands, hugging, or other physical contact.

Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.

Avoid common use pens/pencils – bring your own writing instrument.

	 Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. 					
	There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.					
	4. Substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules. Entries positively close 8:00 P.M. – TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 24, 2020 or when the limit is reached and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.					
	Identification cards and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented upon arrival at the show.					
	 Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any N.S.F. cheques will be subject to a \$25.00 service charge. 					
GENERAL INFORMATION	1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules.					
INFORMATION	 The Brantford & District Kennel & Obedience Club Inc. will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons. 					
	If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.					
	4. Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.					
	 Judging will commence at 8:00 a.m. each day. A later starting time may be specified in the judging schedule. Starting time of each ring will be specified in the judging schedule. 					

6. Show precincts is inside the Concessions Building.

7. No private Videotaping without the approval of the Show Superintendent.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5
*includes the dog awarded Winners.						

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge <u>SHALL NOT</u> be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.8 A Dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that a dog was defeated at the group level, save that no more than five (5) points will be credited to a dog for a single show.

Section 15.1.11 A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

Section 15.1.12. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. **Chapter 4-Section 4.7.3** of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

Chapter 8, Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only," providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the judging of your breed by the owner or handler.

When one or more all-breed and/or specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to Specials Only must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the breed judging scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to Specials Only.

CONFORMATION SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

GRAND CHAMPIONS AND GCH POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Section 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age.

Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level:

Section 15.2.4 The title of Grand Champion shall not be awarded retroactively and all points towards this title must be achieved after the date of January 1, 2013.

Section 15.3.5 The title of Grand Champion Excellent shall not be awarded retroactively. However, dogs that have been awarded the Grand Champion title prior to January 1, 2013, will be awarded the Grand Champion Excellent title on application to the CKC.

Section 15.3.6 Additional Requirements: To attain a Grand Champion Excellent title, a dog must have been awarded a CKC performance title from any CKC event. A CGN, Herding Tested certificate or Chase Ability Program title are not considered performance titles for the awarding of this title.
