****NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE/TCN Number:** The CKC requires all owners of unregistered, recognized breeds entering events to obtain a Temporary Competition Number (TCN). TCNs will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). <https://www.ckc.ca/en/News/2020/March/TCNs-What-Are-They-And-How-Do-You-Get-One> If a dog is not registered individually in the records of the CKC, it may be entered at a trial held under these rules with a Temporary Competition Number (TCN), providing that the number is obtained before the closing date of entries. Once the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will no longer be valid. While there is no fee for the Temporary Competition Number, exhibitors will still be required to pay listing fees (\$10.50) when entering events. The request for a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors should go to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly. Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

GENERAL INFORMATION • It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event is not subject to indignities. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on the receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (See Section 19.7)

Bitches in season - bitches in season are not permitted to compete (See CKC Scent Detection Rule 6.5). We will refund all entry and listing fees if a bitch comes into season after closing date, upon presentation of a veterinarian's certificate. The certificate must be delivered to or reach the Trial Secretary before the trial commences. o
