GENERAL INFORMATION:

Eligibility to Compete - To be eligible to compete in these trials, the dog must be:

- a) Registered with the CKC or;
- b) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or;
- c) Have a Temporary Competition Number, and must be eligible for registration with the CKC.

The entry of a dog that is improperly entered in a class for which it is not eligible cannot be altered to another class after entries close except as outlined here:

a) Exhibitors incorrectly entered in the *A Class* are permitted to move the dog to the corresponding *B or C Class* up to one hour before the start of the trial. b) Exhibitors incorrectly entered in the Novice B class are permitted to move the dog to the Novice C class up to one hour before the start of the trial. c) Exhibitor entered in the Open H classes are permitted to move to the Open 18 classes and vice versa up to one hour before the start of the trial. 6.9.8 d) Exhibitors incorrectly entered in the Novice B class are permitted to move the dog to the Novice C class up to one hour before the start of the trial.

Bitches in season - Bitches in season are not permitted to compete under C.K.C. Rules. We will refund all entry and listing fees if a bitch comes into season after closing date, upon presentation of a veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trials. This certificate must be delivered to or reach the Trial Secretary before the trial commences.

Obedience Classes offered - All regular classes will be offered.

Obedience Prize List - Flat ribbons will be available for all qualifying scores. Rosettes for qualifying First placement for Novice A, B and C, Novice Intermediate, Open HA, Open HB, Open18N, Utility A, Utility B. Flat ribbons for all 2nd, 3rd & 4th placements and title rosettes will be available.

Important Notice to Obedience Exhibitors - There is no limitation on the number of trials at which a dog may be entered as a 'listed dog', except that a dog which has obtained three qualifying scores at obedience trials held under C.K.C. rules, may not continue to compete at licensed obedience trials held under the Club's rules until the dog is registered individually with the C.K.C. Foreign born and owned dogs, please refer to Event Registration Number (ERN) information listed elsewhere.

Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations - The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Obedience Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. Section 20.7 of the Regulations states: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at an Obedience or Rally Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indication that this has occurred.

**If the entry has no individual CKC registration number, an E.R.N. or P.E.N. is required and must appear on the entry form. A listing fee of \$11.50 per entry is also required.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee / Non-member participation fee - An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.

Regular Classes

Pre Novice –This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of P.C.D (Pre-Companion Dog). Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together in the Group Exercise. A dog that has earned the title of C.D. is not eligible for this class. This class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.

Novice A -This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of C.D. (Companion Dog). Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. No person who has previously trained or exhibited a dog through its C.D.X. (Companion Dog Excellent) title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.

Novice B -This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of C.D. (Companion Dog). Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Novice A and Novice B class at any one trial.

Novice C –This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D., C.D.X., U.D., or any Obedience Trial Championship Title prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice C class indefinitely. Scores earned by dog in the Novice C Class are not eligible for High in Trial and do not qualify a dog for any title.

Novice Intermediate – This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D., C.D.X., U.D. or any Obedience Trial Championship. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High in Trial. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. This class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter the Open classes.

Open HA / 18A -This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. (Companion Dog Excellent). Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. Any person who has previously trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class.

Open HB / 18B -This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D. in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. No dog may be entered in both Open HA/18A and Open HB/18B at any one trial. A dog that has earned the title of C.D.X. must compete in Open B. Dogs eligible for entry in the Utility Class are also eligible for entry in this class.

Utility A -This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed that has earned the title of C.D.X., but has not earned the title of U.D. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.C.H title may not handle dogs in this class. Handlers may enter more than

one dog in this class.

Utility B – This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed that has earned the title of C.D.X. or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. No dog may be entered in both Utility A and Utility B at the same trial.

From the West: HWY-401 E toward **Cornwall**. Merge onto **HWY- 416 N** via **exit 721A** toward **Kemptville/Ottawa**. Take the Dilworth exit # 42. Turn left on to Dilworth Rd and drive 1 km. Turn right on to Fourth Line Road and in 8km you will reach the destination - 6361 Fourth Line Road. **From the East: HWY- 401 W** toward **Kingston**. Merge onto **HWY-16 N** via **exit 721** toward **HWY- 416 N/Kemptville/Ottawa/RTE-416 N**. Take the Dilworth exit # 42. Turn left on to Dilworth Rd and drive 1 km. Turn right on to Fourth Line Road and in 8km you will reach the destination - 6361 Fourth Line Road.
