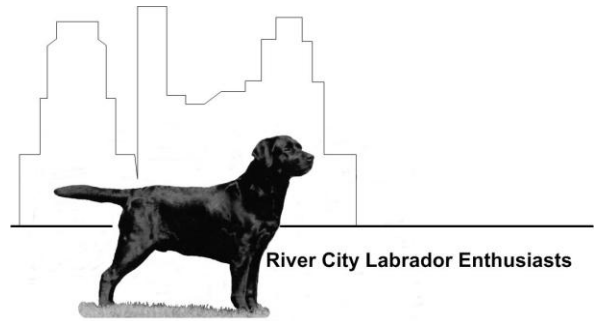

All entries must be accompanied by the full entry fee (and listing fee of \$8.50 if applicable). A listing fee per dog event is payable unless the dog's entry carries a CKC individual registration number or ERN number.**

Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian Dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and cooperation is greatly appreciated.

Canadian Kennel Club Non-member participation fee as of January 1, 2011

A) An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

B) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles being cancelled.

C) All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the non-member participation fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members

ENTRY INFORMATION

No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the Entry Fee. Telephone entries cannot be accepted, except in the event of a postal disruption. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Any NSF cheques/credit card refusals will be subject to a **\$20.00** service charge. Entry fee plus service charge for NSF cheques must be paid in cash prior to test.

Test Details

- Running order will be determined by a draw. Multiple entries by the same owner/handler will be automatically separated unless otherwise requested
- WC followed by WCI followed by WCX in each series
- Ducks will be used in all stakes, land and water
- Meet at 8:30 am, dogs to line 9:00 am
- Check in with Marshall at test site
- All handlers must wear dark or camouflage clothing
- Standard CKC Rosettes to all dogs qualifying in each stake
- Bitches in season MAY NOT compete in the WC tests.

Excerpt from CKC Rules & Regulation for Working Certificate Tests (section 14.7)

It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
