CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE


The Non-Member Participation Fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC; it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

DESS will accept entries when paid by credit card on behalf of the club. The fee for this service is 20% of the total fees. A fee of \$25.00 will be levied on all Declined Credit Cards & NSF Cheques.

RULES and AWARDS

All dogs between the ages of 6 and 18 months on the date of the show shall be eligible to compete, regardless of place of birth. All dogs entered in the sweepstakes must also be entered in a regular class at the All Breed Show, on the day of the Sweepstakes. Money received as entry fee for the sweepstakes will be pooled and divided as follows:

All 1st Place Juniors will compete for Best Junior

All 1st Place Seniors will compete for Best Senior

All 1st Place Opens will compete for Best Open

Best Junior, Best Senior and Best Open will Compete for Best in Sweepstakes

OWNER / HANDLER COMPETITION (OH)

Rules for Owner / Handler Competition

(RESTRICTED TO AMATEUR COMPETITORS WHO HAVE BEEN SHOWING LESS THAN 2 YEARS)

Baby Puppies are not eligible for this competition

1. Owner / Handler Box must be checked on entry form

(A * will indicate each OH dog listed in both the catalogue and on the Ring Steward sheets.)

- This is open to all non-professional owner / handlers. Professional defined as anyone who has been hired to assist a handler or paid to handle or received remuneration or a licensed / permit judge. Dogs must be OH throughout the competition.
- 3. Judging of **OH** will take place after Breed Judging Competition unless automatic.
- 4. OH Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs eligible to compete for BB.
- 5. If the Best of Breed dog is **OH** it will automatically be the **OH BB**.
- 6. If ineligible, then the next highest **OH** placement will compete against the eligible dogs of the opposite sex.
- 7. Should none of the **BB** competitive dogs be **OH** then any **OH** dogs (not directly or indirectly defeated in the classes by an **OH** dog) will be invited back.
- 8. The OH BB dogs will compete for Best OH in Group immediately after Regular Group Judging.
- 9. Should the Regular Group 1st dog be OH then it will be automatically OH in Group.
- 10. If no OH places in the Group (1-4) then all BB OH dogs will be called into the ring for OH Group Judging.
- 11. If the BIS dog is OH, then it will automatically be OH BIS
- 12. A flat ribbon will be offered for Best **OH** in Breed, a Rosette for Best **OH** in Group, a prize for **OH** in Group (Saturday & Sunday) and a Rosette and prize for Best **OH** in Show.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- 1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
- Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone
 and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs
 regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- 3. There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to ind all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
- 4. Substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
- 5. Entriespositivelyclose 9:00 pm, Tuesday, July 19th andmust be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.
- 6. Identiication cards and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the entriesclose. Identiicationcards must be presented upon arrival at the show.
- 7. Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any N.S.F. cheques will be subject to a \$25.00 service charge.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- 2. The Kilbride & District Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.
- 4. Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.
- Judging wil Icommenceat 8 a.m. on Friday, August 5, Saturday, August 6 and Sunday, August 7, 2016. A later starting time may be specified in the judging schedule. Starting time of each ring will be specified in the judging schedule.
- SHOW PRECINCTS: The Show precincts shall consist of all areas set out for rings, all shelters or facilities set aside for show officials, judges or exhibitors and handlers, and an area of 30 feet outside of the judging rings.

CHAMPIONS & CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

<u>SECTION 1:</u> A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

<u>SECTION 2:</u> The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder):

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least on e2 point win either at the breed or group level

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

- Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership with a written request for an ERN.
- Include full payment in the amount of \$57.60 plus tax. Accounts may be paid with personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or Mastercard. For Non-Members please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non-residents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates.
- Provide us with your full return address.
- Faxed requests will be accepted. Please include your VISA/MasterCard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature.
- An ERN must be obtained within 30 day of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibits this or presents a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension.


