COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOL THE CAPE BRETON KENNEL CLUB 2020 SHOWS

As of the date of publication of this premium list, (November 11, 2020) these are the travel guidelines as set forth by our provincial government.

This could change prior to our closing date. If nothing has changed, and you choose to enter, there is a slight possibility the borders may open prior to the show allowing exhibitors from outside the Atlantic Bubble to attend, there will be no refund of entry fees. If it becomes necessary to cancel this show due to changes in provincial guidelines brought on by an increase in the incidence of positive COVID-19 cases all entries will be refunded. We respectfully request that if you cannot or will not comply with these guidelines Do Not Enter or Attend!

THERE WILL BE A ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY ON COVID-19 VIOLATIONS!

Our Waiver must be signed by Club Members, Judges, Ring Stewards, Exhibitors, Owners, Handlers, Breeders, Assistants, Family Members. Contact tracing information must be provided for all who attend (name & phone number) Everyone must wear masks/face shields correctly over mouth and nose: Exhibitors, Judges, Stewards in the rings during judging. They will also be required anywhere on the premises where social distancing (2 meters) cannot be maintained. The ring will have an entrance and an exit.

Exhibitors are encouraged to return to their set up after they have exhibited their dog. **SHOW and GO.**

The Dog Show is NOT OPEN to the General Public. Show Site Access Process: The waiver will be emailed along with the judging schedule, you will be required to print off enough waivers so that every individual in your party has their own waiver. The Waiver(s) will be handed into the club upon arrival at the show site, attendance wristband will be provided at this time only, please be sure to retain your wristband, this is required to re-admission daily.

Our show will have covid security who will ensure all government regulations are strictly adhered. We want to maintain a safe environment in all aspects of our event. We take this very seriously and want to ensure the safety of everyone attending our show as well as the people in their communities to which they will be returning. We also recognize our responsibility to the dog show community to avoid any perceived or actual violations to the public health protocols put in place by our provincial government.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEES ARE IN EFFECT

An annual "Non-member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number.

In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "non-member" will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the "non-member" participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled.

Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by "Non-CKC" members and are not applicable to CKC members

ENTRY INFORMATION:

1. All entries are to be sent to the Show Secretary and must be received by the closing date and time.
2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by proper entry fees and forms.
3. Incomplete entries will be returned. Agents and Handlers please note that full name and address of owners must be filled in.
4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
5. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the show / trials secretary after the closing date and time.
6. Only dogs eligible for CKC registration may enter this show. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
7. A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of Championship, in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 20 of these rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary IN WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.

Rules

a copy of the rules pertaining to dog shows may be obtained from the Canadian Kennel Club. It is the exhibitors responsibility to know the rules pertaining to these events.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

Baby Puppy

A dog 3 months up to 6 months on the day of the show

Junior Puppy

A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show

Senior Puppy

A dog between 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show

12-18 Months

A dog between 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show

Canadian Bred

A dog which was born in Canada

Bred by Exhibitor

A dog owned and handled by the breeder

Open Class

A dog 6 months of age or older

Specials Only

Dogs who are Canadian Champions

TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER (* EFFECTIVE MARCH 2, 2020)

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN).

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly.*

Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

*If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will be a tab called TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account.

Champions and championship points - chapter 15

Section 1 - a dog awarded winners at a championship show held under these rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging 0-5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:

A class dog awarded best in show at an all breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Cape Breton Kennel Club will use care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.
2. Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers should judging times of different breeds conflict.
3. The superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials.
4. In no case may a dog under 3 months of age be allowed within the show precincts.
5. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
6. Only dogs entered in the Shows will be permitted in the building.
7. Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows.
8. **It is the responsibility of the exhibitor/handler to clean up after their dogs outside the ring and outside the building.**
9. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the CBKC, it is impossible to open or complete the Shows/Trials, no refund of entry fees will be made.
10. The Cape Breton Kennel Club will not be responsible for any equipment left on the show premises.
