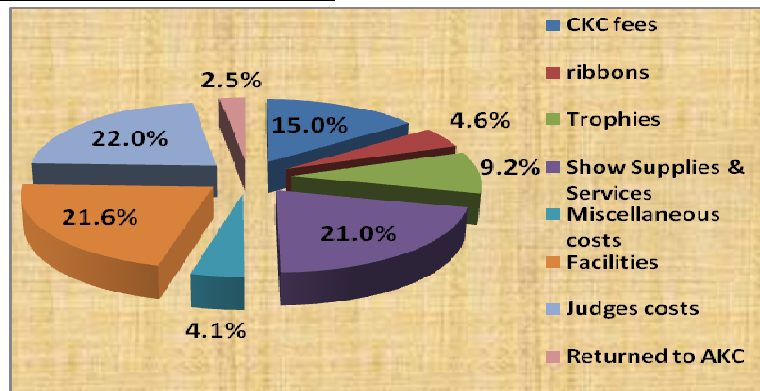

Guidelines for Reserved Benching

- is offered to all exhibitors. It is designed for the convenience of all exhibitors.
 - Any dogs left overnight, are the express responsibility of the exhibitor/ agent.
- On Sunday February 5th, 2012 the space must be vacated within 1 hour following Best in Show.
- All crates, equipment, chairs, etc. must remain within the limits of designated space. Exercise pens in Handler Benching must use plastic under and on the sides.
 - All reservations must be submitted online spaces assigned on first come-first served basis. Grooming space is limited and may be altered by the Alberta Kennel Club
 - If you wish to bench with friends' one person must book all reservations.
- All reservations must be submitted online. No telephone reservations will be accepted.
- Exhibitors are expected to keep their space clean.
 - **Fire Lanes/Aisles must be kept clear.**
 - All dogs must be exercised in the exercise pens provided for that purpose. Exhibitors are liable for all costs related to cleaning or damage caused by a dog (s) under their control. Failure to exercise appropriate diligence may result in a loss of show privileges.
 - Dogs are not allowed through the main entrance doors, even if carried in a bag! Sorry! Stampede Rule
 - No commercial activity may occur within any space without the express permission of the Alberta Kennel Club Show Chairperson. Exhibitors are welcome to have signage on pens or crates indicating which breed they have on display.
- All Dog Show Rules and Regulations of the C.K.C. and the Alberta Kennel Club will apply to the Reserved Benching areas. Exhibitors will be expected to accept space as assigned and keep it clean or this privilege may be withdrawn.**

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation. Conformation Show Rules and Regulations (19.7)

General Information

Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. Should such acknowledgment not be received one week prior to the show, please contact the Show Secretary at (403) 246-2515.

Please note: Dogs shall be exercised only in specified areas provided by the Club. Private exercise pens will be limited. **Owners or agents will not be allowed to exercise their dogs outside or in front of the Dog Show Building. Dogs will also be restricted to the areas of the building designated by the Show Committee. No dogs will be allowed access to or from the building through the front doors.**

The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of any accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, patrons or property.

Dogs not entered in the show will not be allowed on the show premises unless In-Transit. An In-Transit area will be provided by the Show Superintendent.

The Alberta Kennel Club reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Conformation Show Rules and Regulations (8.6.1).

If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the Alberta Kennel Club, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It should be understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children. The Alberta Kennel Club will not be responsible for injury to any child whether by accident or any other cause.

The Alberta Kennel Club will not allow the use of spike or pinch collars on its show grounds.

Please note: According to City of Calgary by-laws this will be a non-smoking show. The Big Four Building has been designated non-smoking.

A ramp will be available for use at the Judge's discretion.

Please note: The show is a public event, candid photos and/or videos may be taken on the show premises. Such images may be published in print or on a web-site without your consent. By entering this dog show, you waive all rights to such images and agree that the Alberta Kennel shall not be held responsible for their use.

Do not leave dogs unattended and please "Stoop and Scoop".

No Entry Will Be Accepted Without Payment in Full. Tendering of a dishonored cheque or declined credit card in payment of an entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. (*Chapter 8.8, C.K.C. Dog Show Rules.*) **Any dishonored cheque or declined credit card(s) will be assessed a \$50.00 service charge.** The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted.

Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks.

To simplify the process, we urge that you pay by credit card, bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.

Please do not send entries by Registered Mail.

Entries sent by Greyhound must be sent prepaid for delivery; there will be no pick-up of entries.

To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Show Secretary after the closing time and date.

Please allow ample time for delays in the mail.

Exhibitors Please Note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry at any time up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but **written or electronic notification must be received by the show secretary not later than closing date and time.** If written or electronic notification is not received, the dog will remain entered in the show.

Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in Rally/Obedience comes into season after the close of entries if a Veterinarian's Certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial) is delivered to the Show Secretary **before** the starting date and the time of the trial. The Alberta Kennel Club will refund entry, recording and listing fees if the above conditions are met.

There will be no refunds on duplicate entries or overpayments.

MOVING A CLASS DOG TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or that has a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of closing of entries for show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the order/handler at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show. When one or more all-breed championship shows and/or specialty shows are held on the same date in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to specials must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to.

ATTENTION - ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS – EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. \$58.50 + 5% GST. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee is (\$57.60 + 5% GST).
- In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"**

*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, <http://www.ckc.ca> under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

Please use the designated indoor exercise areas provided for your dogs.

Extracts From CKC Dog Show Rules

Chapter 8 Entries and End of Show Section

8.2.5 An error in an age specified class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

Section 8.3.1 Entries: Every dog entered in a Championship show must be one of the following:

- registered with the CKC,
- have an Event Registration Number,
- be eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN).

Section 8.4.1 Listed Dogs: If a dog is not registered as in 8.3.1 (a) or (b) but is eligible for registration with the CKC, it may be entered at a show as a listed dog provided:

- that if born in Canada, it is eligible for individual registration;
- that if not born in Canada, is eligible for registration in the records of the CKC.
- that if it is a foreign born and owned dog, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtain from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

Section 8.4.2 Entry of a listed dog at a show must be accompanied by a listing fee as set by the Board in addition to the regular entry fee.

Section 8.5.1 Acceptance of Entries: If indicated in the premium list, an electronically transmitted entry may be accepted provided the entry is accompanied by a credit card charge authorization.

Section 8.5.3 No entry shall be accepted from or on behalf of any person who is officially known to be expelled, deprived of privileges, debarred or suspended by the CKC or any other registering body for pure bred dogs.

Section 8.5.4 After entries close, no further entries may be accepted, cancelled or substituted other than as otherwise stated in this section or as provided for in case of a postal strike.

Section 8.6.1 Refusal of Entries: The authorities of any show may:

- decline to accept entries for just cause, and/or
- refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show building on account of disease or viciousness.

c) in the case of non-acceptance, refund the fee with the reason for non-acceptance.

Section 8.8.2 Fees: Tendering of a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card in payment of an entry fee shall be considered non-payment of said fee and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

Section 8.9.1 Moving a Dog to Specials: A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or that has a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for a show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the owner or handler at least one hour prior to the opening of the show.

Section 8.9.2 If it is established that a dog transferred to Specials Only has not completed the Championship requirements, all awards will be canceled and all ribbons and prizes won shall be forfeited. The owner may also be subject to disciplinary action.

Section 8.9.3 When one or more All-Breed and/or Speciality Shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the moving of class dogs to Specials must be made prior to the scheduled opening of the first show.

Chapter 4 Judges Section 4.1.3 A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

Section 4.1.6 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favor his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act.

Chapter 14 Disqualifying or Excusing Dogs

Section 14.1.4 Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for information on reinstatement, see Chapter 14 Section 14.3 of the Dog Show Rules.

Championship Points and Cancellations

Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 - 5	6 - 9	10 - 12	13 & more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.

Section 15.1.3 If a Dog awarded Winners was also awarded Best of Breed then at the show all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included the total.

Section 15.1.4 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.5 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.6 If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.

Section 15.1.7 The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

Clarification: Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Male shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials Bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

Section 15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that the dog was defeated at the Group level.

Section 15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than 5 championship points in a single show:

Section 15.1.10 A breed or class shall not be allowed more than 2 sets of championship points per sex on any day in the same venue.

Section 15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners which also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with 5 championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

Section 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate, the dog must:

- earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 judges; and,
- be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number.
- have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

Extracts From CKC Dog Show Rules

Chapter 8 Entries and End of Show Section

8.2.5 An error in an age specified class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

Section 8.3.1 Entries: Every dog entered in a Championship show must be one of the following:

- registered with the CKC,
- have an Event Registration Number,
- be eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN).

Section 8.4.1 Listed Dogs: If a dog is not registered as in 8.3.1 (a) or (b) but is eligible for registration with the CKC, it may be entered at a show as a listed dog provided:

- that if born in Canada, it is eligible for individual registration;
- that if not born in Canada, is eligible for registration in the records of the CKC.
- that if it is a foreign born and owned dog, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtain from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

Section 8.4.2 Entry of a listed dog at a show must be accompanied by a listing fee as set by the Board in addition to the regular entry fee.

Section 8.5.1 Acceptance of Entries: If indicated in the premium list, an electronically transmitted entry may be accepted provided the entry is accompanied by a credit card charge authorization.

Section 8.5.3 No entry shall be accepted from or on behalf of any person who is officially known to be expelled, deprived of privileges, debarred or suspended by the CKC or any other registering body for pure bred dogs.

Section 8.5.4 After entries close, no further entries may be accepted, cancelled or substituted other than as otherwise stated in this section or as provided for in case of a postal strike.

Section 8.6.1 Refusal of Entries: The authorities of any show may:

- decline to accept entries for just cause, and/or
- refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show building on account of disease or viciousness.

c) in the case of non-acceptance, refund the fee with the reason for non-acceptance.

Section 8.8.2 Fees: Tendering of a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card in payment of an entry fee shall be considered non-payment of said fee and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

Section 8.9.1 Moving a Dog to Specials: A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or that has a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for a show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the owner or handler at least one hour prior to the opening of the show.

Section 8.9.2 If it is established that a dog transferred to Specials Only has not completed the Championship requirements, all awards will be canceled and all ribbons and prizes won shall be forfeited. The owner may also be subject to disciplinary action.

Section 8.9.3 When one or more All-Breed and/or Speciality Shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the moving of class dogs to Specials must be made prior to the scheduled opening of the first show.

Chapter 4 Judges Section 4.1.3 A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

Section 4.1.6 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favor his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act.

Chapter 14 Disqualifying or Excusing Dogs

Section 14.1.4 Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for information on reinstatement, see Chapter 14 Section 14.3 of the Dog Show Rules.

Championship Points and Cancellations

Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 - 5	6 - 9	10 - 12	13 & more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners.

Section 15.1.7 The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

Clarification: Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Male shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials Bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

Section 15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that the dog was defeated at the Group level.
