Entry limits: A handler may enter a maximum of one dog in each component and game for this event. Your dog must have passed the prior level for a component to register for the next level. Open to all breeds and mixes.

Entry fees: \$35 per Component entry (Advanced & Excellent); \$20 per game, \$10.00 for each dog in a Team.

Entry confirmations: Confirmations will be emailed upon acceptance, please allow 48 – 72 hours.

Entry method: First come basis for online entries until maximum running time is reached.

Payment: Once your entry space is confirmed by email from the host, payment will be accepted by cheque or E-Transfer. Etransfer payment must be received within 72 hours to hold your space (7 days for payment by cheque). Payment details will be sent with confirmation email.

Entry forms: Complete the online entry form and waiver for each dog entered.

Refunds: Refunds will only be given for dogs withdrawn for medical reasons. Veterinary certificates must be presented to the Trial Host or Secretary before Event begins.

Awards: Qualifying ribbons per component pass, rosettes for placements and new titles.



Participant Information:

Training and/or unofficial use of odour is NOT PERMITTED on trial grounds.

DOGS: Dogs must be under control at all times. Do not allow your dog(s) to pee on anything manmade. Pick up after your dog(s) immediately. Dogs must be on leash when not crated or in the search areas. Do not allow your dog to approach other dogs or people without explicit permission. If you wish extra space, please put a red bandana on your dog to indicate your need for additional space to others.

Running Order: running order will be decided by random draw. Order will be posted at check-in.

Bitches in heat: bitches in heat will be allowed to compete and will run last in each component level. **We ask that you notify us ASAP if your bitch is in heat so we can adjust the running order.** Bitches in heat must wear pants.

Food: there are no food services at this venue and there are only limited food options near the trial site (about 10 - 15 min drive) so please bring whatever you need to keep yourself and your dog fed and watered.

Crating: Crating will be in your vehicle. Bring appropriate equipment to keep your dog(s) comfortable.
